## WELCOME TO RCIC

Please make this a special year for your child: they only have First Reconciliation and First Holy Eucharist once. We allow TWO absence for the year. For this reason, please clear your calendars now for weekly class attendance and special event dates. If you miss a class please complete the work and let the coordinator know. There are a couple workshops that do not have make- up dates; Remember they will have many more years to attend soccer games, scouting events...etc. More information will be sent home for these events. Please remember children pick up our attitudes if we are happy and joyful of our faith journey, they learn to be happy and joyful. Attending Mass together as a family helps children learn that Mass is important to their life. The Mass is where families come together to worship and to build their relationship with God and with the community. Church law calls for all Catholics who have reached the age of reason to attend Sunday Mass each week.

**Wednesday, Oct. 14 2018 DEADLINE to turn in Sacramental Information Form** with a *copy* of child's Baptismal Certificate. Children must be Baptized, or have a Profession of Faith to the Catholic Church if they are baptized in another faith, to receive First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion. We must have these verification items on file for a child to receive these sacraments. Children who have been baptized in another faith need to see the sacrament coordinator, Denise Gilbert, to have a Profession of Faith. If your child has **not** been baptized, they will receive all Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil.
