As we anticipate the beginning of Lent, it's time to distribute the spring Lector schedule.


Lector Status. Please welcome any new Lectors when you see them. The table below shows contact information for the Lector Mass Leaders and the number of active Lectors on the schedule by Mass time. In addition to finding a sub if you will not be able to serve as scheduled, please be sure to let the other Lector and/or the Mass Leader for your Mass know. Also forward my weekly reminder message to the Lector who will sub for you.

We are still extremely short at 6:30 PM Sunday. Please let me know if you are able to volunteer to serve occasionally at that Mass.

Lector Procedure Reminder. Please remember to include a distinct pause after proclaiming Reading 1 or Reading 2. A good way to time this is to silently count "1, 2, 3" and then announce, "The Word of the Lord." Then, after turning the page, if necessary after Reading 1, or after closing the Lectionary and putting it on the shelf after Reading 2, we are asked to pause for about 10 seconds. A good way to time this is to silently say a Hail Mary. Please be sure to not cut short the brief pause or period of silence.

Easter Masses. We will use online sign-ups for Easter Masses. The Mass schedule for Easter is the same as last year, including five Masses in the Church, one Mass in the new gym at the Faith Formation Center on Spring Creek on the other side of Independence, and three Masses in the Parish Hall in the Parish Activity Center next to the Church. Lectors who are involved with RCIA will be assigned readings at the Saturday evening Easter Vigil. If you wish to serve at a particular Mass for Easter, you may let me know prior to my making the sign-ups available, and I will sign you up.

Proclaiming the Word of God at Mass is a special calling, and we appreciate your dedication to this ministry. I wish everyone a spiritually fulfilling Lent and a Blessed Easter.
