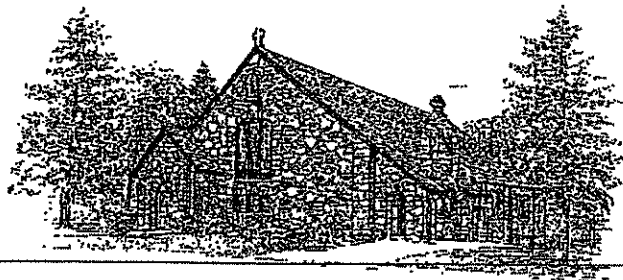

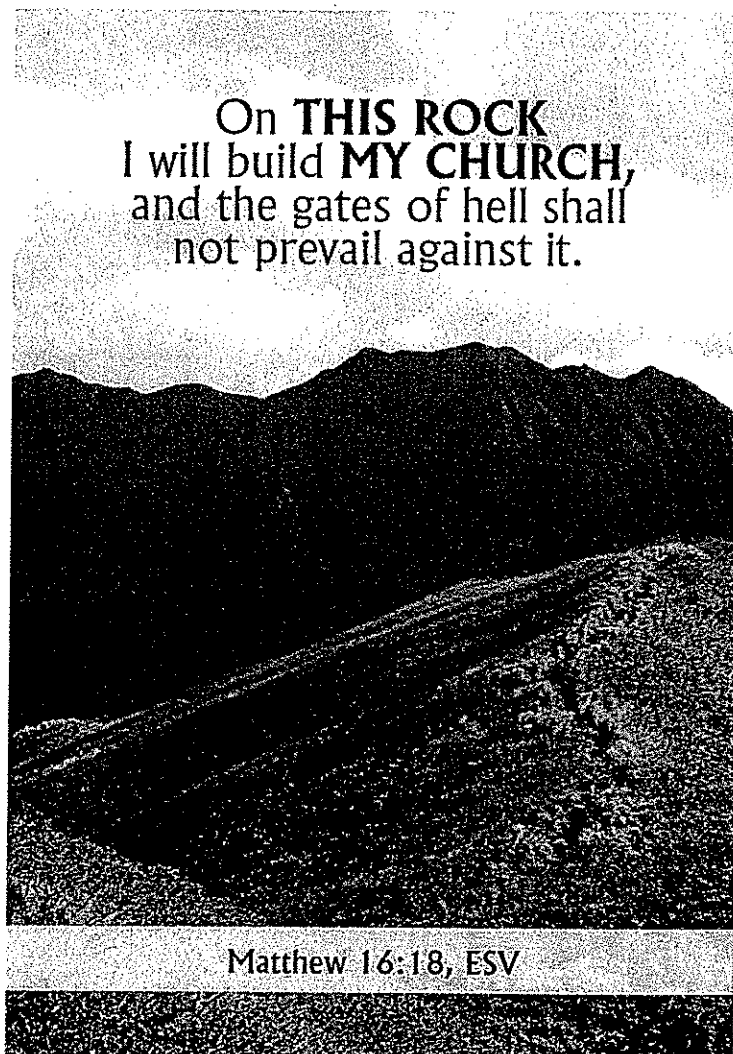

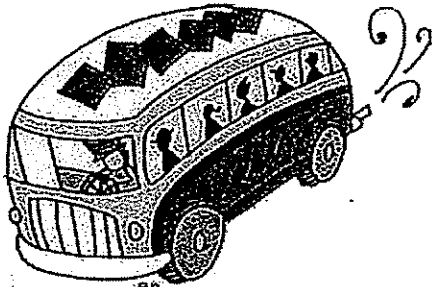

SUNDAY COLLECTION

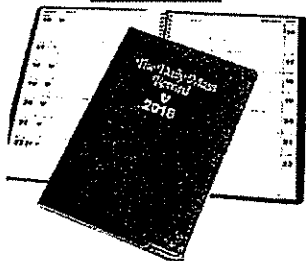
