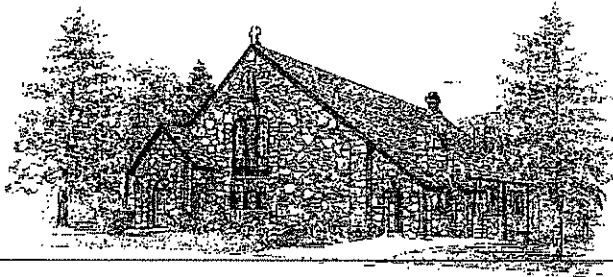

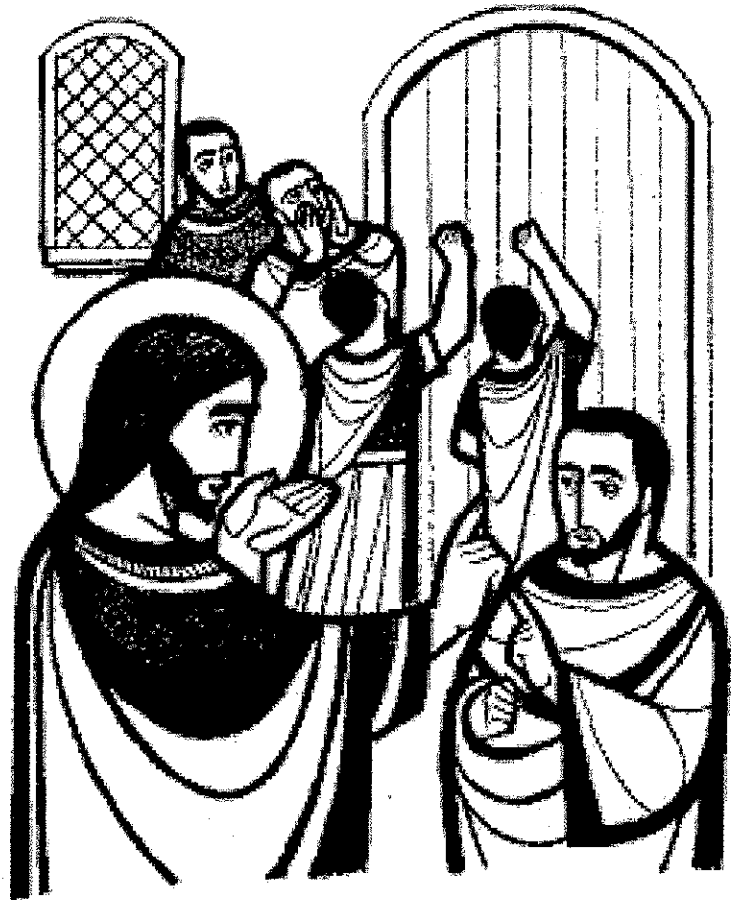
PARISH MEMBERSHIP

WORK TO BE DONE

Outside

- 1 Remove debris from outside rectory kitchen entrance
- 2 Remove debris from side and rear of church
- 3 Remove debris and cut down trees and bushes near dumpster
- 4 Remove debris and cut down trees and bushes near church AC unit
- 5 Cut weeds and clean up around link fence in parking lot
- 6 Remove dead poison ivy growing on church
- 7 Remove weeds from rear rectory garage area
- 8 Remove weeds from retaining walls behind rectory
- 9 Cut down branches that are hitting church
- 10 Apply weed killer where needed
- 11 Cut grass as needed
- 12 Cut down dying trees [those involved to be determined]

Plumbing

- 13 Replace 2 toilet seats in rectory
- 14 Adjust hot water setting for rectory
- 15 Change faucet on rectory laundry room
- 16 Snake drain outside main entrance to the church - clogged
- 17 Clean drains in passageway to church hall& parking lot
- 18 Clean drain in retaining wall near rectory kitchen entrance
- 19 Power wash path to the Blessed Mothers statue in front of rectory
- 20 Install new toilet, vanity and medicine cabinet in Fr. Gus' room

Painting

- 21 Scrape and repaint metal railings
-rectory kitchen entrance and on side of church
- 22 Paint fence outside rectory kitchen entrance
- 23 Refinish church doors
- 24 Painting of rectory rooms

Miscellaneous

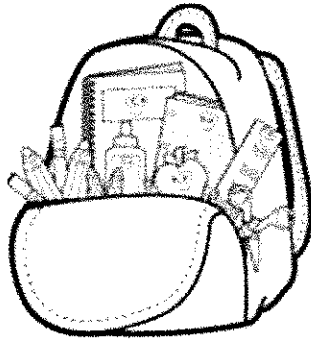
- 25 Clean and organize rectory supply closets
- 26 Fix latch on door to rectory kitchen entrance
- 27 Clean rectory kitchen cabinets and reline with shelving paper
- 28 Clean, replace and check all rectory AC units filters etc
- 29 Replace latch on fence to rectory kitchen

Dispose

- 30 Dispose of TV's – rectory guest room and Religious Ed building
- 31 Dispose of old rectory furniture
