

WHAT IS CHILDREN'S LITURGY?

Children's Liturgy is actually the *Liturgy of the Word for Children*. The Scriptures at our Masses are proclaimed in adult language that young children often do not understand. At Children's Liturgy, we cover the Sunday Gospel and readings at a level the children can understand and enjoy. We try and create an atmosphere where the children are able to experience God and share their thoughts and experiences for the day. Children's Liturgy **DOES NOT replace** Faith Formation class, but further *enhances* the lessons.

Children's Liturgy takes place at the **10:30 a.m. Mass** on Faith Formation Sundays. ALL children ages three through First Grade are invited to participate. After the opening prayer, the presider of the Mass will invite the catechist and the children to the front of the church. He will bless them and they will proceed to the Parish Room in the Gathering Place. Before we begin the *Liturgy of the Eucharist*, the children will return to the pews to join their parents for the remaining celebration of the Mass.

We are looking for one or two more people to share their faith and EXCITEMENT about Jesus with these precious children. Our current catechists will help prepare you to teach these little ones. How can you say *No* to an opportunity to bring Christ into a child's life?
