## Guidelines & Expectations Confirmation I

**MANDATORY: Birth certificate, baptismal certificate, and registration fee are required for a student to be enrolled.**

Students will need to provide a sponsor's name and a saint's name before the end of the year.

Confirmation I is part of The Teen Confirmation program that takes a total of two years.

Teens who have been baptized and received their First Eucharist, can prepare for the sacraments of confirmation. Typically, these are teens in 10th or 11th grade (some exceptions can be made).

The confirmation candidate must attend the CCE classes on Sunday evening, and have good attendance with an 80% or higher percentage.

**MANDATORY: There is one Day of Reflection for Confirmation I.**

There are two fees that need to be paid or make arrangements for payments. One is the CCE fee, and the other is the Day of Reflection fee. **Full payment is due by October 31, 2019.** The confirmation candidate must be respectful and courteous to Coordinator of Youth Ministries, Catechist, and fellow peers.

The confirmation candidate must inform the Coordinator of Youth Ministries on any issues during the school year, which will hamper his/her participation/completion of the Confirmation Program.

There is to be no food, drinks, or gum inside the classroom.

Usage of cell phones or other electronic devices are prohibited during class
