Fr. Jerome A. Degan [1933-2015, 81], pastor of Immaculate Conception-Moville 15 July 1994-15 July 1996 died Saturday June 27. His funeral was at St. Cecelia Catholic Church in Algona on Thursday July 2. He retired in 2001. May he rest in peace.

As people continue to discuss the decision of the United States Supreme Court issued Friday June 26, it is important to remember this decision only affects those who marry according to civil law, i.e. in the county courthouse. This decision does not impact the Sacrament of Matrimony as celebrated by the Catholic Church. Catholics are bound to marry in the Catholic Church unless permission is received from the Bishop and weddings that take place in the courthouse is not recognized by the Church. Thus, "marriage" between same-sex couples is not marriage according to canonical definition (canon 1055).

Today is the Fourteenth (14th) Sunday in Ordinary Time. When Jesus went to teach in his native synagogue, there was such a lack of faith shown in him that he was unable to perform any mighty deeds. Are things different in our life? Are we accepting of all that Jesus could do for us? Or is our lack of faith creating obstacles to the wonderful things Jesus wants to do for us?

The Liturgy requires many ministers. Some of these ministries occur outside of Mass. This week I wish to focus on the ministry of the Collection Counter. These persons are trained to accurately account each weekend's collection and work in teams of two on Sunday or Monday mornings. Counters undergo a background/credit check and Virtus training in accord with Diocesan and insurance requirements and training by the parish bookkeeper. We are in need of some additional Collection Counters as the few we have are asked to count the collection there are times when counters need to work up to four times a month. If you know of anyone who would make a good Collection Counter [adult], please ask them to volunteer using the form inside this bulletin.

Pray for the consecration of Russia to Mary by the pope. May God bless you.

Question #139: What is the lay vocation?

The LAITY are sent to engage in society so that the kingdom of God can grow among men. [897-913, 940-943]

A lay person is not a second-class Christian, for he shares in the priestly ministry of Christ (the universal priesthood). He sees to it that the people in his walk of life (in school, family and work) come to know the Gospel and learn to love Christ. Through his faith he leaves a mark on society, business, and politics. He supports the life of the Church, for instance, by becoming a lector or an extraordinary minister, by volunteering as a group leader, or by serving on church committees and councils (for example, the parish council or the board of directors of an institution). Young people especially should give serious thought to the question of what place God might want them to have in the Church.

LITURGICAL MATTERS

OTHER LITURGICAL MINISTRIES: In addition to the ordained ministries, some roles in the Liturgy are exercised by lay people who place their time and talent at the service of the liturgical assembly as altar servers, lectors, extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, cantors, choir members, instrumentalists, leaders of song, and ushers. Others contribute their time and talent to planning and organizing the Liturgy; to keeping the church and the vestments, vessels, and appointments clean and well ordered; or to providing decorations that reflect the spirit of the liturgical feast or season.

WHAT IS NFP?

FROM: "By any measure, natural family planning is a winner" by Archbishop Joseph Naumann. [... continued from last week]

Advocates of artificial contraception will point out that couples utilizing NFP to avoid pregnancy must refrain from sexual intercourse during certain days, while those using oral contraceptives need not abstain. This is true. However, according to the testimony of NFP couples, while abstaining is not always easy, it actually serves to strengthen their marital relationship. These periods of abstinence force couples to utilize other ways to express their love for each other. [to be continued...]

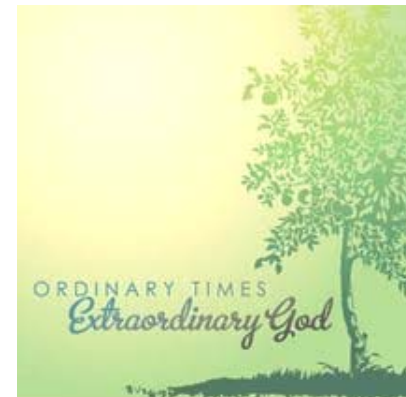

From the Code of Canon Law (the law of the Roman Catholic Church) ON THE TEMPORAL GOODS OF THE CHURCH

can. 1277 The diocesan bishop must hear the finance council and the college of consultors in order to perform the more important acts of administration in light of the economic situation of the diocese; he needs the consent of this council and that of the college of consultors in order to perform acts of extraordinary administration besides cases specifically mentioned in universal law or in the charter of a foundation. It is for the conference of bishops to define what is meant by acts of extraordinary administration.
