WHAT POPE FRANCIS' STATEMENTS ON MARRIAGE LAW REFORMS DO, AND WHAT THEY DON'T DO

Pope Francis this week issued two major documents reforming the judicial system of the Catholic Church in the areas of the Church's marriage law. The Holy Father introduced the reforms by means of two Apostolic Letters given on Tuesday, Sept. 8, 2015.

Fr. James J. Conn, SJ, Professor of Canon Law at the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome, explained during an interview on Vatican Radio that the changes announced by the Holy Father specifically address the question of speediness in processing cases involving people seeking marriage annulments from Diocesan Tribunals. Prof Conn, SJ, went on to explain that – contrary to speculation and even some reporting in both secular media and Church circles – the reforms promul-

gated by Pope Francis constitute no change in the Church's understanding of the nature and fundamental structure of marriage, nor do they alter the basic purpose and scope of the Church's judicial system.
