Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

We live in a world where people are preoccupied with threats that will bring about the “end of the world”. Apocalyptic stories, supernatural powers, vampires, aliens and a host of other deadly or destructive scenarios fill our imaginations and are reflected in our TV shows, films and video games. Even churches get caught up in this (remember “Left Behind”?). Whether the triggering cause of the great ending is our environment gone out of control, a new disease pandemic, a nuclear holocaust, or even zombies, we live in a time of apocalyptic fervor. But the conditions that bring such speculations to a boiling point are much the same in any age or season: there is a gnawing fear that pervades people, a sense that a stable and secure world has come to an end and that nothing we do will bring it back again.

In response, we remain a people of hope and a Church of promise. Our Lord has conquered sin and death and has promised that if we believe in and follow him everything will be okay. Jesus never promised us that he would fix all of our problems or make all of our troubles go away, but he did promise that he loves us and that he’ll be with us. That if we are faithful, no matter what happens he will get us through it. So what does that mean? A Pollyannaish, “bury your head in the sand” approach to what is going on in our world? NO! We are people of hope. We don’t have to fix the world, we only have to do our best and take care of what we can.

What does that mean? First and foremost- PRAY! Every day, throughout the day. Ask God for help, guidance, and mercy. Thank God for your blessings and ask for his grace to be bestowed on everyone you meet. Secondly, be a person of peace and joy. Trust in God and encourage others to do the same. Share with others the reasons for your faith and conviction. Third, get involved in activities that increase your knowledge of God and God’s will. Start watching the videos available online through our FORMED service. Want to really grow in your faith? Teach it to others! Help in our Religious Education program or RCIA programs. Finally, share of yourself. Donate to worthy causes, spend time with those who are hurting or in need of help, get involved with groups or organizations that make things better. We need a lot of help in our parishes, there are all sorts of committees, groups and other ways that we could use your assistance and in the process make things better for others. Not only is doing these things worth the effort, but they will change your life and the lives of those around you for the better.

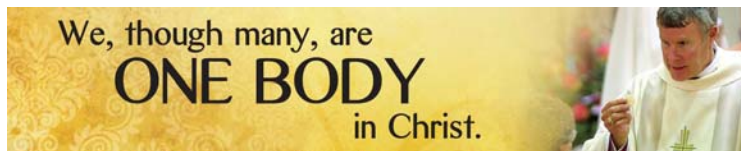

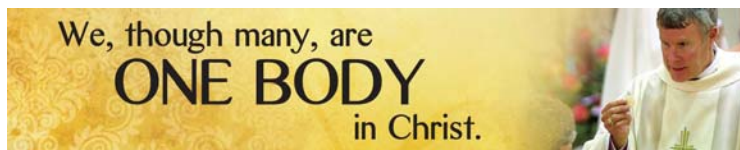
