Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Why do St. Michael's and Immaculate Conception parishes exist? They exist to make Jesus present to our families, communities and world. We accomplish this by loving others and becoming better disciples.

- Discipleship begins with God. To the person who feels discouraged, hopeless, even dead, Jesus says: "Young man/woman, I tell you, arise!"
- By discipleship God calls us to greatness and we have no excuse for not responding. If God can forgive and restore King David - who sunk so low as to have Uriah killed to cover up his adulterous affair with Uriah's wife Bathsheba - he can do the same for you and me. We have no excuse for not responding.
- By overcoming our reluctance and working to become better disciples, we realize our full potential. Right now you may feel limited, but in Jesus --and in Jesus alone-- will we find true freedom and complete fulfillment. I hope that sounds appealing because in this week's gospel we see the hard part. To follow Jesus means He has to be more important to us than any other consideration. Some people are shocked at the ways Jesus underscores the urgency of following Him.

To the man who asked for time to bury his dad, Jesus replied, "Let the dead bury their dead..." To the man who wanted to say goodbye to his family Jesus said, "No one who sets a hand to the plow and looks to what was left behind is fit for the kingdom of God." In other words, to be a disciple means to put our efforts into forging ahead, not looking back. I've been a priest 14 years and I've seen many people start out with enthusiasm only to fall away. Instead of keeping their "hand to the plow", when they meet an obstacle or disappointment, they start reconsidering, looking back and thus lose sight of the goal. An essential part of discipleship is consistency. Do you remember last week when Jesus spoke about taking up one's cross daily? Each morning is a new beginning. Prayer is so important in helping us accomplish this. Can you give at least 20 minutes a day to prayer? I cannot emphasize how much it would help if you would. Consistently being present to God in prayer makes a world of difference.

We see that in our relationships. Recently I read of a survey that asked women whether they would prefer financial security or emotional security. Here's the exact question: "If you had to choose between two bad choices, would you rather endure financial insecurity/struggles arising from financial insecurity or lack of closeness in your relationship?" By over 2 to 1, women responded that they would rather endure financial insecurity. Many men feel their primary responsibility is to provide financial security to their family, but their wives do not see it that way. What they want is emotional security. Being there. Consistency. They add that "it's more important to have him around and emotionally close - both for me and the kids" - even if it meant having less money, older cars, less fashionable clothes and far more basic vacations. There's probably no huge surprise in this.

Guys, if emotional closeness is what your wives and children want, think how much

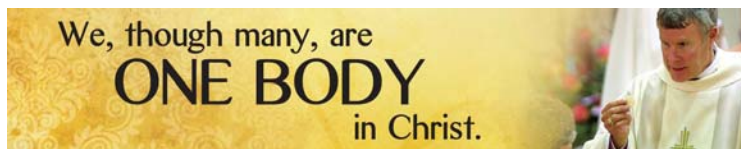

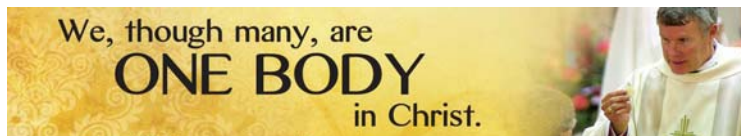
