**The Most Holy Trinity**

Washington D.C. is not the first place you'd look to find examples of living hope. No, I'm not referring to politicians but to the people of its inner-city. Like many cities Washington D.C. struggles with the ills that make its neighborhoods anything but neighborly. We hear so often of crime, of drug abuse and street gangs, of school dropouts, families without fathers and the crumbling of our society. Because we continuously hear about these things, we're liable to begin shaking our heads, wincing in disgust, and muttering something about "those people."

Isn't it easy to assume the moral high ground by casting others to the low ground? It's the oldest trick in the book: to judge yourself right with God by judging others to be wrong. Mind you, I'm not attempting to gloss over the failings of our society. Human weakness is real. Lack of care --for others and even for oneself-- is an everyday reality. But every so often, just when we're ready to write-off "those people", we discover reason to believe in people's basic human goodness.

The SEED Foundation of Washington, D.C. is a public boarding school that prepares high-risk youth for the challenges of life. Its success is amazing. SEED provides young people with stable living conditions, thorough academic preparation, and a hopeful outlook as they work to build a better way of life.

This is good news. But what are even more notable are the parents of these children. It's not just the children, but their parents who long for a better life. These parents hope against hope that SEED will accept their child even though that means sending them off to boarding school. In droves they show up at the annual lottery where the names of some 80 lucky new students are selected at random. Coming from our worst neighborhoods, these parents know all about the scourge of poverty and the emptiness of false pursuits. They want something much different for their children, a chance for a better life. Imagine that kind of hope. All from... "those people."

This week we meet another of "those people" --a tax collector named Matthew. Sitting at his customs post he looks respectable, but in the eyes of his fellow Jews Matthew was one of "those people". Back then, the title "tax collector" held about as much honor as "child molester." Tax collectors were Roman collaborators. They'd bribe Roman officials for the right to extort money from the people.

So what happens? Along comes Jesus and Matthew hears the call, "Follow me." He wastes no time and leaves at once. Of all the people Jesus could've picked, he settles on one of "those people." If Jesus had only asked, respectable people would've warned him that there are prospective disciples who are far better than an unscrupulous tax collector! But God doesn't see things the same way we do. For God there is only one category of people: his beloved children. Whether we are broken, jaded by sin, in need healing, or just want to live better lives, we remain his beloved children.

Too often we don't see it that way. We see the sins and declare the person a sinner, the tax collector is a traitor, the high school drop-out is lazy, the addict is hopeless, etc. Too often we find ourselves enmeshed in a web of judgmental and self-righteous ways of thinking. But even at our worst, there is still hope. These times can still be turning points in our efforts to grow in the love of God. For at these same moments the Lord meets us wherever we're at in our lives and, with eyes of compassion, calls to us saying, "Follow me."

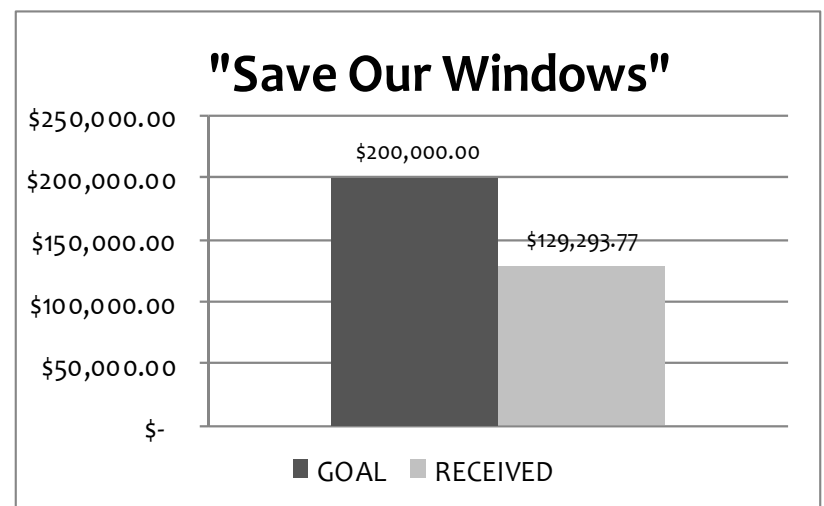
