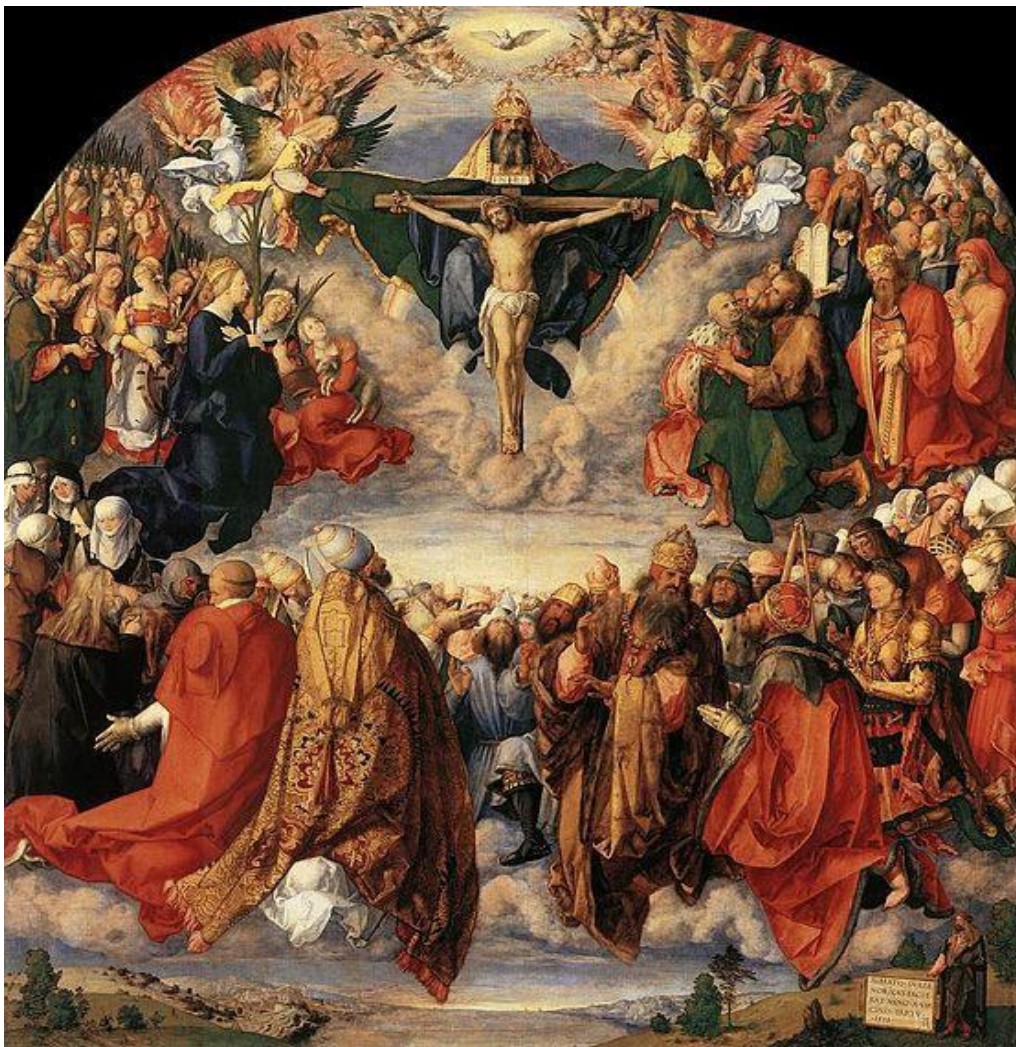


# FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

## Wisdom of the Saints

All Christ did, all he taught, was the will of God.
