

Life Teen Voucher Program

The Life Teen Voucher Program has been developed to give Active Members of St Joseph's Life Teen program the ability to offset the costs for Trips and Events held by the program by performing Community Service. It is completely voluntary, and can be used for any of the programs offered below.

Terms and Conditions

Teens must be Active Members of the Life Teen Community to be eligible to participate in this program.

Vouchers are issued in denominations of **one voucher unit per hour** of Community Service.

Teens are limited to earning thirty (30) voucher units per term.

Vouchers must be used during the term in which they are earned. They do not roll over to the next term.

Vouchers cannot be transferred to another person without the written consent of the Life Teen director.

No voucher may be requested for more than three (3) hours.

The Community Service hours must be approved in advance by the Life Teen director, who shall assign a unit value to the service. Once assigned a value, service cannot be awarded for more units than was assigned.

Teens are subject to CORI checks if they want to do Community Service outside of the Church building.

Service Requests that originate from an individual (ex. Residential yard work) must submit to CORI checks if they are requesting Community Service at their place of residence, at their own expense.

Community Service

Community Service shall be defined as work done for the parish or another civic or religious organization such as babysitting at a parish event, visiting elderly in a nursing home, or volunteering as a helper in a food pantry or homeless shelter. It does not include activities in conjunction with a school or the fund-raising activities of another civic organization, such as a bottle drive.

Active Members

The Life Teen Director shall define what an Active Member is in terms of attendance, participation, and any other criteria which they deem appropriate.

These are the programs and functions that are eligible for voucher use during the 2017-18 term.

Teen submits a Voucher Service Request completely fill out.

Life Teen Director approves and records Service Request. Teen brings form to Community Service project.

Teen submits completed form to Life Team Director, who requests the Voucher Unit from Bank Committee.
