

#### BRIEF SUMMARY OF PARISH COUNCIL, March 4:

- Jim Krautscheid reported that the farm will be leased by Grant TeVelde under the same terms as we had with Paul Sligar.
- Kathy reported that Bob Konen checked out the roof last Fall and found it to be in worse shape that he expected. He took care of some minor repairs to get us through the winter. The council is leaning towards a metal roof and will ask Bob to put in a bid, as well as looking for a couple of other bids.
- We are waiting for a bid for a new (or upgraded) sound system.
- Marylou Krautscheid, Dora Trevino and Irma Sepulveda were there to explain changes they would like to see to our funeral dinners.
  - They asked about having the funerals start earlier so the dinner and clean up could be done earlier. Fr. Mario said funerals could be at 10:00 a.m. or 10:30 a.m. instead of 11:00 a.m.
  - Using regular dishes was discussed, but it was decided to use paper plates and cups, not foam, and regular silverware instead of plastic.
  - Marylou expressed her concern about hot food not being kept to the temperature required by the Health District. They would like to have a few menu options to eliminate the problem of having so many hot dishes and the need to keep them warm.



The Council asked them to draft up a proposal with the changes for the next Council meeting. The three of them and Kathy Konen will address the congregation at Mass to ask for more volunteers in order to put together a new funeral dinner list.

- The discussion about funeral dinners included complaints about the kitchen. Food in the refrigerator is not always covered, the refrigerators are dirty and pans of oil being left in the oven, are just a few of the issues. We need to be in compliance with the Health District.
- Kathy reported that the church had a new coat of paint. She still plans to paint the duct work outside to blend it in, and has some areas inside the building to touch up, i.e. around emergency lights and in classrooms.
