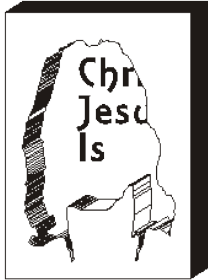

THE IMAGE OF GOD

Try to imagine meeting an alien being who is pure energy; who has no physical form; who is pure intellect; and who is immortal. How would you be able to relate to such a being? How would you communicate? How

would you be able to love such a being? This is not science fiction. It is a description of the problems we have in dealing with God. Of course, God is

not an alien. God is an infinitely loving creator. But we are so unlike God that we might as well be aliens ourselves. God solved the problem by appearing on earth in the person of Jesus. We can relate to God because we can relate to God's human form. Paul tells us that Jesus is the "image of the invisible God." In other words, the qualities of love and mercy and humility that we see in Christ are a perfect reflection of the same qualities in God. Jesus is God made visible.
