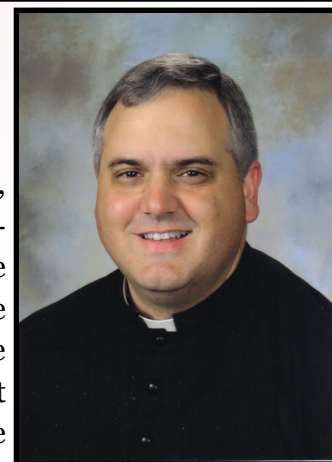

Dear Parishioners,

Happy Birthday to the Church today! While we won't bring out a cake, and the only candles that will be lit today will be those on the altar and sanctuary for Mass, it is nonetheless on the feast of the Pentecost that we celebrate the birthday of the Church. The miracle of Pentecost 1,980 years ago was that people from all over the world could understand in their own native languages what the Apostles said, particularly in sharing the good news about Jesus Christ. That miracle continues today, and you and I are responsible for it continuing! While surely the Holy Spirit calls men to the priesthood, and men and women to consecrated religious life to be appointed witnesses to Jesus in the Church today, the Holy Spirit calls YOU! The Spirit calls you to be alive in your faith! Sunday Mass is good and necessary, but your faith is much more than that! The Spirit breathes in you to be good teachers to your spouses about what real love is. The Spirit empowers you to be loving, courageous, firm and forgiving parents to your children; that same Holy Spirit calls you as parents to be the first teachers of your children about Jesus, about what it means to live a sacramental Catholic life. The Holy Spirit moves all of us to be people who pray all through the day, who allow our Faith to influence strongly our moral decision making, our business moves, our very being! Yes, that same Holy Spirit who moved the 3,000 in Jerusalem to be baptized and become Christians is still very much alive today and in need of you to cooperate! Carpe diem! Seize the day! Receive that gift of the Holy Spirit today again, and let Him guide your life in God's ways! What miracles will happen if we do!

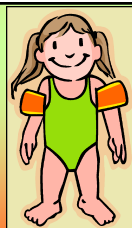


The suggestion box continues to give some good insights, as did the recent Parish Council meeting for May. One item that was raised at Parish Council was to help you know which preface and Eucharistic prayer we priests use at Mass. The Sacramentary, the book of prayers that we use at the altar, contains nine major Eucharistic prayers and a multitude of prefaces, many of which are proper to the liturgical season. As a general rule, Monsignor Calkins uses the Roman Canon, the first Eucharistic prayer. I'll use that one from time to time as well, usually at high feast days like today, the Pentecost, or Easter, Christmas and so forth. Normally, I use the third Eucharistic prayer for most Sunday Masses. As to the prefaces, there are many choices for us, which sometimes are made at the last minute. While I sometimes think ahead to use the fourth Eucharistic prayer, which has a proper preface to it, I often choose the preface based on a phrase from either the Gospel or a point in my homily I wish to tie together in the prayers. I can't say we'll be able to tell you which preface we use ahead of time, but that's our rationale in general. It was an interesting suggestion, and one that came via the recently concluded study of the Mass that the groups conducted on Thursdays and Sundays. Thanks for the input!
