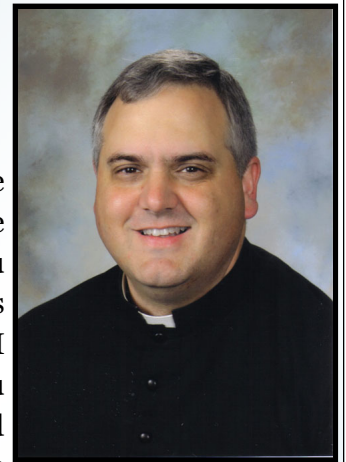

Dear Parishioners,

Please take some time this weekend, while you are at Mass, to fill out the survey about the potential time for the second daily Mass we will be adding. I have gotten good input from our Parish Council members about it, and several of you have dropped suggestions in the suggestion box, but I want as broad an input as possible before making the decision on adding the time of the second daily Mass. I will also appreciate your insights into why you choose the particular time that you choose. I know we won't be able to please everyone with the suggested second Mass time, and I it may actually come to pass that we end up with more than one set time for the second daily Mass (i.e., Mondays at 12:10 p.m., Tuesdays at 7:00 p.m., etc, then Wednesday - Friday 7 a.m., just for examples). There are pros and cons to each time being considered, and the solution won't please everyone, but hopefully it accommodates the greatest number of parishioners who can't get to 8:45 a.m. daily Mass who want to get to a daily Mass. That's my goal. Thanks for your input.

I'd like to thank Scott Samford, our youth minister, for his good work in organizing the 6 p.m. youth Masses we have had for the last three months. It goes without saying, so I'll say it anyway, that the young people who volunteered as ushers, readers, musicians, and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are also to be thanked. We will resume youth Masses once a month in late August or early September.

Since summer's heat is already upon us in middle spring, it is time to remind everyone, men and women, to do your best at preserving modesty in your dress at Masses. Trust me, I of all- - - who always have on the most clothing in church- - - know what the heat does to us, but I also know it's important to strive to put your best on for the Lord. It's also important, I believe to keep a spirit of propriety and modesty in dress so that none of us becomes an occasion of sin for anyone else by the way we dress at Mass. You would be outraged, and rightly so, if I showed up to say Mass in a ratty tee shirt and holey jeans. While I'm not going to go into a tirade against anyone, I do want to encourage all of you during the summer to keep up appearances!

One final issue that came up at the May Parish Council meeting was the large number of people who leave Mass early, particularly on Saturday afternoon at vigil Mass. This is your fellow parishioners calling you out, friends, not me as your pastor, but I see their point. I know, everyone has a thousand and one good reasons for why they have to leave early. I want to challenge you to think of a good reason why you want to stay LATE with the Lord! That's not just at Saturday vigil Mass, but at all the Masses. If God is so good to you and me as to give us His son in Holy Communion, why NOT spend a few extra moments to thank Him? So what if you're not first out of the lot? I'm sure your staying a little longer for a prayer of thanksgiving will be quite pleasing to the Lord, and probably beneficial to your spirit as well!
