Special Feast Celebration



Thursday July 16th is the Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. We will have Taize Prayer that evening in honor of the feast. Father Pat will enroll those who wish in the Brown Scapular of Our Lady of Mount Carmel as part of the celebration.

The Brown Scapular of Our Lady of Mount Carmel is a long-time devotion in the Catholic Church. Carmelite friars and nuns wear the scapular—the long panel of brown cloth that hangs over the shoulders front and back—as part of their habit. For over five hundred years many Catholics have worn a small version of this scapular as a sign of affiliation to the Order of the Brothers and Sisters of Our Lady from Mount Carmel (The Carmelites). Today that popular scapular is two postage size pieces of brown cloth held by ribbons over the shoulder.

Scapulars will also be blessed and available after the 11:30 Mass next Sunday, July 19.

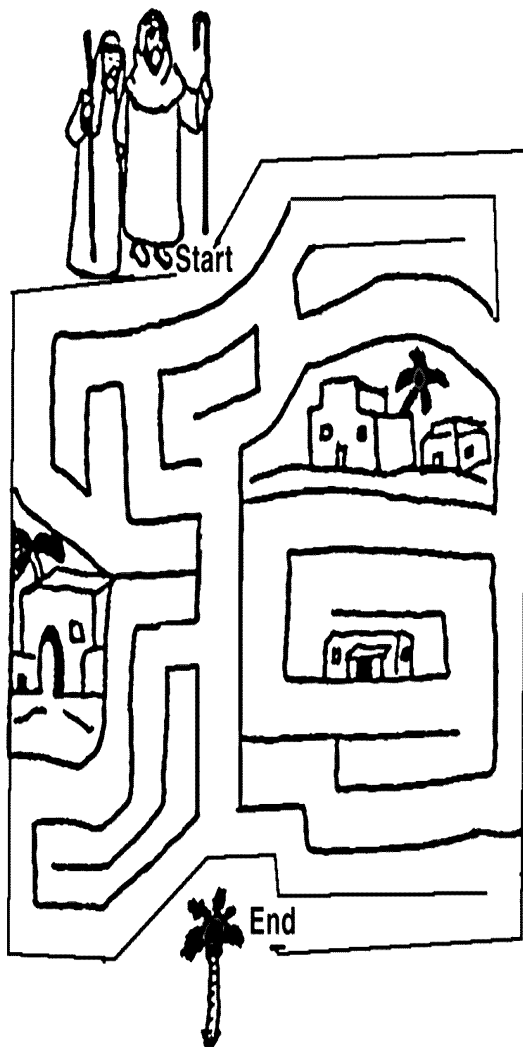
