2018 MASS BOOK

The Mass Book for 2018 will open on **Wednesday, March 1, 2017.** There are some changes this year, and we ask for your patience, understanding, and cooperation. Due to the fact that after our merger we lost 300+ Masses per year and our Mass book filled very quickly, we are limiting the number of Masses you may purchase per household. Each household will only be allowed to reserve **2 weekend Masses and 3 weekday Masses when the book opens.** **You MUST reserve in person from March 1 – March 17, 2017.** If Masses are available after August 1, 2017, each household may reserve 2 more weekend and 3 more weekday Masses. We would like to keep this policy to allow as many people as possible to reserve Masses and not sell out a year ahead of time. We ask that you also consider the options of our Memorial Book and sanctuary candles in lieu of a Mass. Thank you for your cooperation.
