Reading

In Reader's Workshop we will continue to work on building good reading habits. Students will use visual cues in pictures to read challenging words. Students will learn to read through all parts of the word. Additionally, students will reread familiar stories to learn new details.. In phonics we will be learning short o.

Math

Chapter assessment on Tuesday, 10/9 and Wednesday, 10/10. We break the assessment into two parts as to not overwhelm the students. We will begin our next chapter- Subtraction Strategies.

Writing
