Students will begin the second unit of Reader's Workshop. We will be learning about Informational (nonfiction) texts. This week we will examine Super Storms by Seymour Simon. We will begin to learn about nonfiction text features. In phonics we will review ending blends.

Math

The review of these fact families helps students build fluency. This week we will examine word problems and key words that help us determine if we are adding or subtracting.
