our learning

Reading

Students will begin the second unit of Reader's Workshop. We will be learning about Informational (nonfiction) texts. This week we will examine *Owls* by Mary Dunn and *Hang On Monkey* by Susan Neuman. We will begin to learn about nonfiction text features. In phonics we will review ending blends.

Math

Chapter 5: Addition and Subtraction Relationships begins this week. In this chapter students will continue to learn about fact families. The review of these fact families helps students build fluency. This week we will use addition to check subtraction, use related facts to solve problems and decide if addition or subtraction is needed to solve problems.

Religion

Students will be learning about the Church Liturgical Year. We will be learning about Ordinary Time, Lent and Advent.

Writing

Students are experts in so many things and they are doing a great job writing about the things that they know. This week they will learn to elaborate their ideas by asking questions, writing twin sentences and adding detailed pictures with labels.

Science

Students will discover that sound travels in waves. We will conduct experiments that allow students to use their sense of sound to identify mystery objects. We will also discover how vibrations create sound.
