Reading

This week students will select a non-fiction book to read to their Kindergarten partner. We will review important things readers do such as using a teaching voice, and bringing drama to important things that we read. In phonics we will learn about the TH and WH diagraph.

Math

Students will continue to explore numbers to 120. We will identify numbers using place value and begin exploring tens and ones. Students have been working on solving riddles. For example this number has 5 tens and 3 ones. If you are counting by 10s what number is bigger than 73 and smaller than 83? This is great practice for home too. See if they can create a place value riddle for you to solve.

Religion

Students will learn about the Good News of Jesus and the Catholic family.

Writing

Students continue to work on their chapter book. This week we will add different kinds of writing to our book such as lists and how to booklets. Students will create introductions and conclusions for their topic.

Science

Students will explore light this week. We will discover different properties of light and discover what happens when light hits different objects.
