## our learning

### Reading

Students did an excellent job reading to their kindergarten partners before break. This week we be working on the comprehension strategy of visualization. We will be reading *The Owl Moon*, *I Need My Monster*, and *Dreams* to help practice this skill. In phonics we will learn about inflection endings (-s, -ed, and -ing).

### Math

Students will continue to explore numbers to 120 in Chapter 7. In this chapter we will be comparing numbers by looking at place value. Students will learn the symbols for greater than and less than. This is a short chapter. The assessment will be next week.

### Religion

Students will learn how Jesus was a Peacemaker. We will explore forgiveness, and learn more about the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

### Writing

Students will finish revising and editing their chapter book. They will be rewriting their story and getting it ready to publish. Students will be creating a cover, an author's page and finalizing their table of contents.

### Science and Social Studies
