Winter Uniform

Before we know it, it will be November and that means students will be in Winter Uniform. This means all students will be in navy pants and white oxford (button-down) shirts with school logo. Girls may also wear plaid jumpers and skirts but not skorts. They may also wear school uniform navy sweaters, fleeces, sweatshirts or the new uniform red sweatshirts. Students in PreK and K may continue to wear white tennis shoes. Students in 1st-8th should be in leather, dress shoes (not dark tennis shoes) and wear a belt with their pants. Girls may wear white or navy tights. No red polos should be worn during Winter uniform.
