The Usual Move: Grilling a Steak

Your healthier move: Spear some kabobs.

Grilling is a no brainer when you are trying to eat healthy, right? Not always. The char and smoke from the grilling process can actually produce carcinogens that attach to you meat. But there are ways to have your seared beef and eat it, too. One approach: Think small. Kabobs cook faster than larger cuts so they don't have time to absorb smoke. Plus, you typically add veggies to skewers, so you tend to eat less meat. Also, Marinate. High acidity marinades made with lemon, vinegar, or wine make it harder for smoke to stick to your food.
