Letter from the Principal

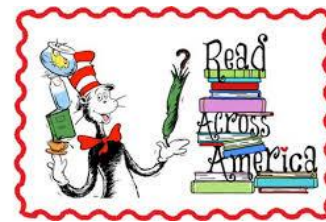
