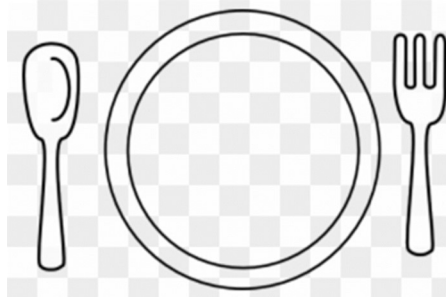

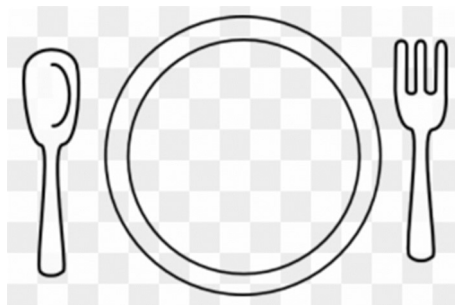

### **Lenten Retreat 2019**

Lent and Easter comprise the most important time of the entire liturgical year. Unlike Advent there is no emphasis on shopping for gifts, setting up the Christmas tree, and other yuletide preparations.

Instead the emphasis is on penance, prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, not to mention the corporal works of mercy. Join us this Lent as we embrace the real meaning of Jesus' Journey to Calvary, and His Resurrection and Ascension into Heaven. Over a period of six weeks we will embark on a community retreat of 40 hours over 40 days by examining the traditional Lenten spiritual disciplines through prayer, small group discussion, reflection, and personal witness.
