### SACRAMENTAL LITURGIES: BAPTISM

After the opening dialogue the celebrant welcomes the infants who are to be baptized in the name of the entire Christian community. The priests and deacons present trace the sign of the cross on the foreheads of the babies and the parents and godparents are invited to do the same. This is the very root of the Christian tradition, one of the oldest signs of our belief in Christ is passed from one generation to the next. It is a sign that does not need to be done only at the baptism, parents and other family members should be encouraged to make the sign of the cross on or with their child frequently. It becomes a teaching moment and a reminder of our own union with the Lord.
