SACRAMENTAL LITURGIES: BAPTISM

The religion text for the early church in its instruction of candidates for baptism was the Lectionary, that is the collection of Scripture reading for Mass.

This is still the principal text that is used in the RCIA for adults. The liturgy of the Word is a necessary part of the celebration of baptism for infants as well. It is in the proclamation of the scripture that we listen to the voice of God. We hear that word addressed to those of us already baptized and directed to the infants and their families and godparents. The priest or deacon in their homily bring out the connection between the words of the Lord and the reason for our gathering. It is the hope that these children will always be nourished spiritually by God's word.
