# SACRAMENTAL LITURGIES: ADULT BAPTISM

The period of the Catechumenate may last as long as a year or at least a few months. Then after consulting with the catechumen, his or her sponsor, and the members of the formation team a decision is made to advance to the next stage. This stage is the rite of election when when the catechumens are elected to be fully initiated into the Catholic Church through Baptism, Confirmation and Communion. These are normally celebrated at the Easter Vigil.
