As newly baptized and initiated they will continue their training throughout the Easter season both at the Sunday Eucharist and on their weekly sessions.

This final period of the RCIA is called the Mystagogia (the 50 days of Easter leading to the great Solemnity of Pentecost). It is when they ponder more fully the mysteries of the sacraments that they have celebrated.
