Statistics Show Young People are More Prolife

YOUTH REACHING OUT TO ICU MOBILE

Statistics show that the next generation of young people is more prolife, and that encouraging news is being felt at the March for Life in Washington, in high schools and churches around the country, and even reaching us here in the ICU Mobile offices. In a 2015 Public Religion Research Institute survey, 52 percent of millennials said the label 'prolife' describes them somewhat or very well, and a 2013 poll showed that 52 percent of people aged 18 to 29 favored bans on



abortion after 20 weeks, compared with 48 percent overall.

Here at ICU Mobile, we have been blessed with the encouragement of young people sharing our mission. The Lakers for Life student prolife group from Prior Lake High School has offered once again to assist us at our annual banquet. In addition, a student from Chaska High School will be completing her senior project by volunteering with us and learning about sidewalk counseling from another local prolife ministry. Sharing her project with her peers will be a unique opportunity for evangelization. Younger students are also standing for life—our mail recently contained a letter from an 11-year-old homeschool student with a generous donation and an invitation to bring the mobile unit to visit her homeschool co-op. Knowing that these young people understand the dignity and value of every life is such a blessing and encouragement to our staff and volunteers!
