be turned into these caps, then donated to a number of hospitals for
distribution. A half-skein can be turned into a cap or used for striping

that it will be used for someone in need. Donations may be dropped
off to the Parish Offices after January 4th.

We are also considering starting an evening knit/crochet group
(that would also meet once a month). If interested, please call the
