Spence-Chapin is delighted to announce the development of our first domestic Granny Program at the Elizabeth Seton Pediatric Center in Yonkers, New York, where most residents require total care to help them interact with the world around them. While the residents of Elizabeth Seton have busy and structured days filled with stimulation and activity, nights are quieter, and bedtime is a natural time to crave one-on-one attention. The Granny Program at Elizabeth Seton will help each child with their nighttime routine by providing a consistent comforting presence at bedtime. Each Granny from Spence-Chapin will be paired with one child at the Elizabeth Seton Pediatric Center, providing regular companionship, interaction and socialization thus enhancing the child's quality of life.
