This week's first reading seems an apt summary of last week's festivities:

*On this mountain the Lord of hosts
will provide for all peoples*

A special thank you to all involved in last weekend's celebration: I am most grateful!

There is a word that we discussed at this week's Parish Council Meeting that I thought should be mentioned here: **evangelization**. Simply defined, evangelization is the proclamation of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We are called, as a parish community, to be both evangelizers and to be evangelized. In other words, we must both **speak** and **hear** the Gospel. Because of our parish-wide commitment to evangelization, we have reorganized the Parish Council into three committees: (1) Evangelization: focusing on how we learn and experience our faith and share this gift with others; (2) Liturgy: reflecting upon how we pray together as a community; and (3) Corporal Works of Mercy: engaging the Gospel to care for those most in need in our parish and beyond.

Please pray for the work of the Parish Council as we continue to reflect upon how we may be leaders in the universal work of evangelization. (And stay tuned for some exciting initiatives that we are planning!)
