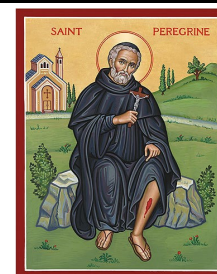

My Dear Friends in Christ,

Happy Easter! This Second Sunday of Easter, known to many as Divine Mercy Sunday, is the eighth day of Easter, and, as such, the completion of the Easter Octave (= eight). Just as eight days after Christmas we celebrate the Solemnity of Mary with great rejoicing, so too do we celebrate this day one week after Easter.

The story of Thomas' encounter with Jesus is a fitting Gospel story for this day, since it highlights for us the truth that it is Christ who seeks us out, even when we feel ourselves most unworthy. This is the message of Divine Mercy Sunday: God's power to forgive and call us back to Him is at its strongest when our doubts, fears and concerns are most prevalent. As a means of celebrating this offer of mercy we will enter more deeply into prayer with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament immediately following the 11:30 am Mass. Confessions will be heard from 12:30-1:30 pm and then 4:00 pm - 5:00 in the Main Church (middle confessional, Mary's side). The Divine Mercy Chaplet will be held at 3:00 pm. We will then celebrate solemn vespers at 5:00 pm and end our afternoon of prayer and praise with Benediction.

Next weekend, at the conclusion of all the Masses, the Sisters of Life will build on this Sunday's message of mercy, and briefly outline their ministry of healing, reconciliation and grace.
