

School Dance Conduct and Appearance Code

Students must present this signed permission form to be admitted to the dance. A new permission form must be presented at every dance.

Student behavior is expected to reflect Christian ethics and be in accordance with the religious and moral expectations of a Catholic School.

CONDUCT CODE:

- Offensive language, obscene gestures and sexually explicit or unsafe dancing is not allowed.
- Handholding is the only acceptable form of affection allowed.
- No fighting allowed.
- Disrespectable behavior toward any administrator, teacher or chaperone is not allowed.
- All cell phones will be collected by your school's chaperones at check in. Phones will be returned at the end of the dance. Students caught with a phone during the dance will be removed from the dance.

APPEARANCE CODE: *Attire for the dance must be modest and age-appropriate as determined by the on-site administrator or designated representative.*

Girls:

- No backless, strapless, halter, spaghetti strap, camisole strap blouses or dresses may be worn.

Boys:

- No baggy style attire.
- Pants must be worn at the waist.

Both Boys & Girls:

- Hats, bandanas, headbands or sunglasses may not be worn.
- Inappropriate words, graphics, symbols, decorations, or chains are not allowed on clothing.
- Purses and backpacks are not allowed.
- No flip-flops may be worn.

The school reserves the right to remove any person who is in violation of the above standards of conduct and appearance from the dance and the student will not be entitled to any refund of monies paid. Additional consequences may be issued by the administration at the student's home school site.
