Dear Friends;

It is my honor to be a member of the Board of Catholic Charities in Dutchess County. A few days ago we had our annual "Spirit of Service" Awards Dinner at Villa Borghese in Wappingers Falls.

It was really a remarkable night. We were able to celebrate four dedicated human beings. Dedicated to what? Dedicated to serving the human race, especially those who are less fortunate.

One person honored was Lawrence Paggi, an engineer from Fishkill. His firm, Paggi Engineering is known throughout Dutchess County for its high quality services and its commitment to the community, especially Catholic Charities. I know him personally as a very devout and lifelong Catholic.

Another person honored was Mary Marshall. Mary Marshall (just retired) has given 24 years of her life to Catholic Charities. In 2012, she led the formation of Catholic Charities of Dutchess County while serving as Executive Director. I have worked with Mary Marshall since I joined the board, and she is a very serene and even-tempered leader, and truly cares about the poor and marginalized of Dutchess County. Mary Marshall is a parishioner at St. Joseph's in Millbrook.

Also honored was Sister Anne Young, O.P. She became a Sister of St. Dominic of Blauvelt in 1959. She was a teacher at St. Denis/St. Columba School from 1969 to 1985, then principal at the same school (in Hopewell Junction) from 1985 to 2010. That is service at the same school for 41 years!

The last (but not least) person honored was Fred Apers. Fred joined the staff at Cardinal Hayes Home for Children in 1973. He served as Executive Director for 42 years of the agency which serves over 100 individuals with severe developmental disabilities. I am on the Board of Directors of Cardinal Hayes, and have had the pleasure of knowing Fred for several years. (Our former convent is a group home for Cardinal Hayes).

We give thanks to God for these amazing people and their deep dedication to living out every day a life of service!
