On a serious note, though, as the Second Vatican Council teaches (i.e. the REAL Vatican II, not some made-up fantasy spirit of Vatican II, but the real council with its real documents), in *Sacrosanctum Concilium*, the document on the Sacred Liturgy, paragraphs 112 and 120:

**"112. The musical tradition of the universal Church is a treasure of inestimable value, greater even than that of any other art...**

**120. In the Latin Church the pipe organ is to be held in high esteem, for it is the traditional musical instrument which adds a wonderful splendor to the Church's ceremonies and powerfully lifts up man's mind to God and to higher things."**

Think about that! Of all the incredible art that the Church has, beautiful paintings beautiful churches and architecture, etc., Vatican II teaches that the greatest of all is the Church's treasure of sacred music.

And in our Latin (i.e. western) branch of the Church, to which we all belong, among this treasury of sacred music, the pipe organ is to hold this particular esteem. Again, according to the Second Vatican Council.

But this is not a new teaching; it has long been the teaching of the Church!

As Pope Pius XII wrote, "**Among the musical instruments that have a place in church, the organ rightly holds the principal position, since it is especially fitted for the sacred chants and sacred rites. It adds a wonderful splendor and a special magnificence to the ceremonies of the Church. It moves the souls of the faithful by the grandeur and sweetness of its tones. It gives minds an almost heavenly joy and it lifts them up powerfully to God and to higher things.**" (Pius XII, Encyclical, *Musicae Sacrae*, paragraph 58).

For all of these reasons it is just so awesome that we are getting an organ for our parish, and that will be able to give it to Baby Jesus as one of His birthday presents, along with our service to the poor and needy in our big Christmas Dinner on January 9.

And what's great too is that we now have the people who can really play it. So we have to get the best organ that we can! Don't forget, you are the Corn Flakes of churches here in Clovis, *The Best and the Original*™.

What will be so beautiful is that God will always be able to look down on His beloved parish's new organ and see in it a gift of love from all of His beloved children here. That's why all of us are pitching in so that we can afford to get the best one for Him. It is a gift and an offering to God that will last and give beauty and splendor to your church and will give "glory to God in the highest" for years and years to come!

It's a gift from all of us, so all of us need to contribute. The more generous more people are, the better organ we can get. I mean, it's your Christmas present to Jesus, so please be generous!

After all, the birthday of Jesus is the "reason for the season." The biggest present you give for Christmas should be the one that you give to Him.

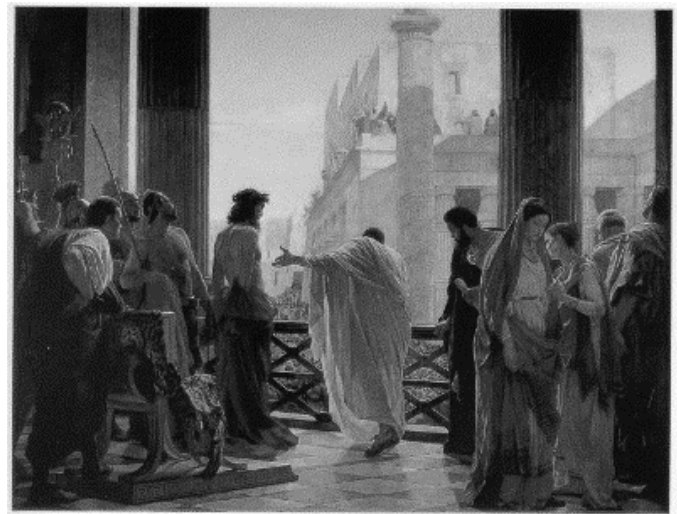
