Exciting News - Family Formation!

We all know how difficult it is to pass on the faith to the next generation, particularly in our current culture with all of its complexities. Parent's jobs are increasingly demanding; family life is busy; relationships are complex; and children are involved in a plethora of activities. We see these challenges played out every week in our religious education classes. Therefore, we have undertaken the serious task of examining new methods for teaching the Catholic faith for K-6 Grades. How can the Church better serve parents who desire to form their children, but are not sure how or even where to begin? How can the Church better serve all parents - including those who are single, divorced, non-practicing, or inter-religious? Future generations of Catholics require a robust response!

After much consideration, the decision has been made to transition our religious education from the classroom model to a Family Formation setting. Family Formation is a program designed to assist families in learning the Catholic faith through Home Lessons, assisted and supported by the pastor, parish staff, and a core team of volunteer parishioners. Family formation consists of one monthly lesson taught at the parish, and three others that are taken home and taught by the parents. At the parish session, children meet in grade level classrooms and are taught by trained volunteer catechists, while parents meet in the church for a teaching on the same topic by Fr. Justin or myself. Parents also receive hints on how to teach the monthly home lessons. The parish session also includes an intergenerational activity, which helps families understand the lesson in a fun and more dramatic way. While we refer to this new program as Family Formation, in many ways it is really adult and child formation.

If you would like to grow in your understanding of the faith in a way that fits into a busy lifestyle, I encourage you to become involved! Many volunteers are needed to serve as catechists, greeters, hospitality coordinators, and helpers.

One final and important aspect of this change is the implications for our 7-8 Grade students preparing for Confirmation. These students will have the opportunity to attend class on Sunday mornings, prior to the 11:15am Mass. Offering class at this time for these middle school students allows for smaller class sizes and better opportunities for the students to connect with their catechist and peers. It also provides an opportunity for our young people to be involved in the liturgy in a more direct way; perhaps serving as cantors, lectors, greeters, etc. Please visit our website to learn more about Family Formation and Confirmation Preparation, and how you can become involved in this exciting new area of parish life!

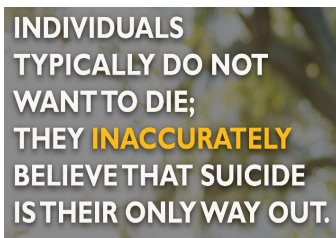
