PENTECOST

Filled With the Spirit

At Pentecost, we commemorate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, a gift from Jesus to the Church. Catholics receive this gift for the first time at Baptism, becoming temples of the Holy Spirit. At Confirmation (our own personal Pentecost), we are sealed with the Holy Spirit and are given the grace to witness to our faith through the gifts of the Holy Spirit. We receive an indelible mark and a commission to spread the Gospel. In the Rite of Confirmation, the bishop or priest says:

*"All powerful God, Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, by water and the Holy Spirit you freed your sons and daughters from sin and gave them new life. Send your Holy Spirit upon them to be their helper and guide. Give them the spirit of **wisdom** and **understanding**, the spirit of **right judgment** and **courage**, the spirit of **knowledge** and **reverence**. Fill them with the spirit of **wonder** and **awe** in your presence. We ask this through Christ our Lord..."*

Jesus told his disciples multiple times after the Resurrection that he would send the "Advocate," the "Spirit of Truth," or the "Paraclete." The Lord left His Blessed Mother with the disciples to encourage them and model faithful expectation for them. Now Christ had ascended to the Father. The disciples again wrestled with doubt and fear. How would they go on without Jesus? How could they fulfill the difficult task of preaching the Gospel to all nations?

Through all their doubts, discouragements, and weaknesses, the disciples can remind us of ourselves. We received the Holy Spirit at Baptism. We have an opportunity to grow in the Gifts of the Holy Spirit at Confirmation. Yet, for many, Confirmation has just become a "rite of passage" or, even worse, the last time they will attend religious education or even Mass.

The disciples in the closed room may have had the same mixed feelings before their Pentecost. They had been waiting and praying for ten days. Suddenly, "tongues of fire" rest on each of them. They are filled with the Holy Spirit and go forth proclaiming the Gospel in different languages with great courage. Why doesn't our own personal Pentecost have the same effect?

Scriptures tell us that "the Spirit blows where it wills." God chooses to work most often through the ordinary events and circumstances of daily life. Only a prayerful and humble soul can see His great works done in ordinary events. We often do not open ourselves up to use the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. Do we really desire to spread the Gospel message? Do we believe that the Catholic faith is the truth? Do we even believe in any objective truth at all?

Let us pray on Pentecost that God would inspire us with the same fervor that lead the 11 disciples to travel throughout the known world to spread the saving message of Christ. May we be open to the ordinary and extraordinary ways the Holy Spirit wishes to work in our lives.
