Trust in the Lord

August 13, 2017
ORDINARY TIME 19

As we grow older and wiser, we come to recognize that life is very fragile. Like the flowers, we are here today and gone tomorrow. We live in fear of anything that might bring us to the grave. Fear makes cowards of us all, young or old, rich or poor, saint or sinner. We are afraid to live and afraid to die. We endlessly search for ways to help us cope with the storms, the stress and strain of everyday living. But the only thing we have to fear is fear itself.

When we do look back on any stormy experience, we sense and know in faith that God's care, concern and love have made all things well in time. We give thanks and remember that our God is a provident Father who understands all of our fears, anxieties and worries. Yet, when we face a new storm or hardship we need to go through that agonizing renewal of faith and trust all over again. Like St. Peter, who was not sure, we try to walk on water. Without faith and keeping our eyes on the Lord, we begin to sink! All we can do is hang on for life and reach out in the darkness to find the Lord's hand.

Some people think that to be afraid is a sign of weakness. But fear really can be a healthy emotion. Without it, we would live reckless lives. Fear can bring about an awareness of the fact that we are not God, that we are dependent upon Him for all that we have, all that we are and all that we can become. We are to remember that He is Lord of Life, of all creation, your life and of mine. Fear is an opportunity to gather our strength, to use our skill and to deepen our faith and then ride out the storm with confidence and trust in our God. The challenge is that we are to try to be calm in spite of all of our anxiety and tension, knowing that God loves us and will be with us no matter what.

As people of faith, we know that our God is present in those stormy, dark times as well as those times when all is well. He is like the calm in the eye of the storm. He makes His presence known in many and unexpected ways if only we are people of faith willing to put all of our hope and trust in Him.

The apostles were powerless as they huddled in their tiny boat tossed about by strong head winds. There was nothing they could do except let the wind take them where it would. They were terrified. It was at that moment that they recognized the Lord in their midst and the seas became calm. Isn't it interesting that Elijah could not find God in the strong wind, in the earthquake, or in the fire, but rather in a tiny whisper? And all was well.

During those difficult and dark days, we are to be like Elijah and the apostles. We wait in silence, with open hands and hearts, listening and knowing that the Lord of all creation will come to save us in ways we least expect. After all He is our God and we are His holy people.

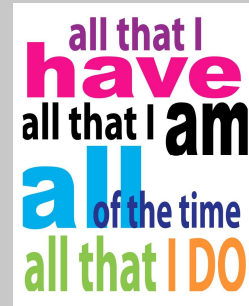

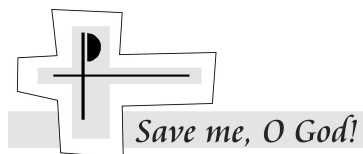
