WORDS FROM OUR PASTOR / PALABRAS DE NUESTRO PASTOR

We all have our unique experience of God and our own personal faith. We can learn from others, but when it comes down to our faith in God, it is our day-to-day experience that really counts. It is our prayers, problems, wonders and wisdom, doubts and despair, faith, hopes and love that speak to us in our every day experiences. It is God who reveals Himself from moment to moment in all that life has to offer, in people, events, the trials and tribulations that help us to grow, change and become something more and/or different.

The mystery of life, love, birth, death, beauty, joy, pain, betrayal and suffering speak to us in another language. Words cannot fully express what we sense or feel. All we can do is to embrace by the moment and know that God has touched our lives again.

We say our God is "one" and yet our God is "three." We say God is like a family. But there is more. We cannot truly understand the mystery of our God. Our understanding of God must not only be an exercise of the mind, but also an awareness of the heart and a strengthening of our imagination.

Jesus has told us that He is the revelation of the Father's love. To know Him is to know the Father. Like any Father worthy of the name, God provides and cares for His family. He shares in their joys and sorrows, their success and failures. He is always there. Our God is a compassionate God, and Jesus is the sign of that compassion.

We say that God is transcendent and yet He is within all of creation, within you and within me. In some beautiful and mysterious way we share in His very life because we are created in His image and likeness. In other words, we share in those magnificent powers of knowing and loving. To know is to love and to love is to become one with the beloved.

We say that it is the Spirit that empowers us to act in a God-like way. The Holy Spirit is the advocate, the Paraclete, the source of all our holiness. It is the same Spirit that prompts us to bring about the kingdom, to be a sign of God's love for all that the Father has created. Jesus showed us how to live and how to die, doing the Father's will. It is His Spirit that gives us the power to do what we are to do as His followers.

The God we know is the God we experience each and every day of our lives. If we are too busy, we will miss the God who wants to break into our hectic lives to surprise us and make us aware of His love. If we are too busy worrying about tomorrow we will miss the beauty of today. If we never appreciate the gifts and well timed events of our day, we will never rejoice in the goodness of our God who delights in each and everyone of us. In every experience of life we are to seek and find the God who creates us, saves us and sanctifies us, the God who makes us one in His love.

Jesus again reminds us as He did His disciples. I have much more to tell you but you cannot bear it now. Jesus knows our limitations, our humanness. He knows our search for truth and happiness. His Spirit will guide and direct us in His ways. That is His promise to all who are baptized in His name.

Son nuestras oraciones, problemas, maravillas y sabiduría, dudas y desesperación, fe, esperanzas y amor lo que nos habla en nuestras experiencias diarias. Es Dios quien se revela de momento a momento en todo lo que la vida tiene para ofrecer, en las personas, los eventos, las pruebas y las tribulaciones que nos ayudan a crecer, cambiar y convertirse en algo más y / o diferente.

El misterio de la vida, el amor, el nacimiento, la muerte, la belleza, la alegría, el dolor, la traición y el sufrimiento nos hablan en otro idioma. Las palabras no pueden expresar completamente lo que sentimos o sentimos. Todo lo que podemos hacer es ser acogidos por el momento y saber que Dios ha tocado nuestras vidas nuevamente.

Él conoce nuestra búsqueda de la verdad y la felicidad. Su Espíritu nos guiará y dirigirá en Sus caminos. Esa es su promesa a todos los que son bautizados en su nombre.

QUESTION: What do we mean when we speak of "original sin"?

ANSWER: In the third chapter of the book of Genesis we hear of the fall of Adam and Eve – i.e. of "original sin." Last week we looked at the story of Adam and Eve, but how do we understand the meaning of "the fall" and its implications for humanity? It is a tremendously important question because Christianity makes little sense apart from an adequate understanding of original sin: there would be no need for a redeemer if there was nothing from which we needed redemption.

Bishop Robert Barron offers a wonderful description of original sin: "It is the arrogation unto oneself of what properly belongs to God alone, namely the prerogative of deciding for oneself what is good and what is evil." In other words, original sin is precisely the replacement of God with oneself – of making one's own will and prerogatives the measure of good and evil. If this sounds eerily familiar, it should, as it has been a core human tendency throughout the ages. There exists an inherited tendency to try to make it through the world alone, relying on our own efforts, and deciding the right path based on our own will. We call this tendency – or this wound to our nature – "original sin." It is interesting to note that Adam and Eve, after that first sin, saw themselves as naked, and became afraid. This points to the fact that they did not experience the freedom and power that they desired, but instead felt lonely and vulnerable.

The Church's understanding of original sin – following the insights of St. Paul, who reflected on the Genesis account – is that our nature has been wounded by the sin of our first parents, but not completely corrupt. This has enormous implications for our lives in society and community. Many thinkers throughout the ages have gone astray by seeing our human nature as either fundamentally corrupt or fundamentally good and unwounded. But the Church's view leads us to see that we all carry a wound, that can be healed by Christ. How this healing happens is a topic for another week.
