## WORDS FROM OUR PASTOR / PALABRAS DE NUESTRO PASTOR

Isn't it strange how life has a way of shattering many of our hopes and dreams? We plan a special weekend for family and friends, and it rains for forty days. We have great expectations for a son or daughter, and they decide to do things their own way. We have a great opportunity for a bigger and better job, and someone else is hired. Life is filled with all kinds of disappointments, from simple broken dreams to broken hearts. It is all part of the fabric of every day living in the real world.

It is very interesting to see how Jesus dealt with the disappointments of life. He had begun His public ministry and the response had been enthusiastic, at times even overwhelming. He was excited about what was happening and decided to return home to his native Nazareth to bring them the good news. His life-long neighbors and relatives listened to His teachings and were impressed. But instead of responding to the message, they began to wonder about the messenger. "Isn't He the carpenter, the son of Mary? Don't we know His brothers and sisters? Now, where did He get all this?" He was just too much for them. The scripture goes on to tell us: And because of their lack of faith, He was not able to do much good in His hometown.

The one thing He wanted more than anything else was a generous response to this good news. It seemed as though they were curious about this native Son, even amazed by Him. But they were not ready to accept those new and crazy ideas. He had asked too much of them and they were unwilling to change. Of course, Jesus was disappointed - who wouldn't be? No prophet is without honor, except in his native place, among his own kindred and in his own house. He needed a reminder that life had not singled him out as a failure. Many of the earlier prophets had also been rejected and ignored. Many modern day prophets suffer the same fate. They had a cause and because they spoke an unpopular truth, they suffered and paid dearly. Jesus was able to understand what was happening and He did not see all this as a total rejection. It really said that He was numbered among those great and influential people, the prophets of old. Maybe Jesus was disappointed, but He was not discouraged. In fact, He was more determined to make the best out of a disappointing situation and I think that is the challenge He presents to you and me this day.

Mark goes on to say: "He could work no miracle there apart from curing a few who were sick." He was unable to help the many, but He was able to help the few. Rather than be disappointed about all that could be done, He would do as much as He was able. Even though His preaching in Nazareth was mostly a failure, it was not a total loss.

¿No es extraño cómo la vida tiene una forma de destruir muchas de nuestras esperanzas y sueños? Planeamos un fin de semana especial para familiares y amigos, y llueve por cuarenta días. Tenemos grandes expectativas para un hijo o hija, y ellos deciden hacer las cosas a su manera. Tenemos una gran oportunidad para un trabajo más grande y mejor, y alguien más es contratado. La vida está llena de todo tipo de desilusiones, desde simples sueños rotos hasta corazones rotos. Es parte del tejido de la vida cotidiana en el mundo real.

Es muy interesante ver cómo Jesús lidió con las desilusiones de la vida. Había comenzado su ministerio público y la respuesta había sido entusiasta, a veces incluso abrumadora. Estaba entusiasmado con lo que estaba pasando y decidió regresar a su hogar en su Nazaret natal para darles las buenas noticias. Sus vecinos y familiares de toda la vida escucharon Sus enseñanzas y quedaron impresionados. Pero en lugar de responder al mensaje, comenzaron a preguntarse sobre el mensajero. "¿No es él el carpintero, el hijo de María? ¿No conocemos a sus hermanos y hermanas? Ahora, ¿de dónde sacó todo esto?" Simplemente era demasiado para ellos. La escritura continúa diciéndonos: y debido a su falta de fe, no pudo hacer mucho bien en su ciudad natal.

Lo único que Jesús quería era una respuesta generosa a estas buenas noticias. Parecía que todos sentían curiosidad por este nativo de su ciudad, Jesús, incluso se asombraban por que él hacían y enseñaba. Pero no estaban listos para aceptar esas ideas nuevas. Jesús pedía demasiado y no estaban dispuestos a cambiar. Por supuesto, Jesús estaba decepcionado - ¿quién no sería? Ningún profeta es sin honor, excepto en su lugar natal, entre su propia parentela y en su propia casa. Necesitaba un recordatorio de que la vida no lo había señalado como un fracaso. Muchos de los primeros profetas también habían sido rechazados e ignorados. Muchos profetas modernos sufren el mismo destino. Tenían una causa y porque hablaban una verdad impopular, sufrieron y pagaron caro. Jesús pudo entender lo que estaba sucediendo y no vio todo esto como un rechazo total. Realmente decía que estaba entre las personas grandes e influyentes, los profetas de antaño. Quizás Jesús estaba decepcionado, pero no se desanimó. De hecho, estaba más decidido a sacar lo mejor de una situación decepcionante y creo que es el desafío que nos presenta a usted y a mí este día.

Marcos continúa diciendo: "Él no podía obrar ningún milagro allí aparte de curar a algunos que estaban enfermos." No pudo ayudar a muchos, pero pudo ayudar a los pocos. En lugar de sentirse decepcionado por todo lo que se podía hacer, Él haría todo lo que pudiera. Aunque su predicación en Nazaret fue principalmente un fracaso, no fue una pérdida total.

I think the same wisdom applies to your life and mine. Whenever we have to settle for something less than our hopes and dreams, we can go on to make the most of what has been given.

Like all people, Jesus, who shares our human nature, knows all of our pain and suffering of disappointment. But unlike many, He was not defeated by it. He accepted that reality and did what He could, and then moved on to the next thing that life had to offer. We all know that disappointments are part of life and we can expect them. By following the Lord's example, we can make the best out of those experiences, for the Lord is always with us in the bad times as well as the good. It is our faith that assures us of His presence.
