## SCRIPTURE REFLECTION / REFLEXION DE LAS ESCRITURAS

Happy and blessed Easter to all St. Rose's parishioners and all who are visiting this Easter Sunday.

We have joyfully arrived at this first day of the week in which some women went in tears very early in the morning to the sepulcher to anoint the body of Jesus with perfumes. But Jesus is no longer there, He is risen! and is waiting for his disciples in Galilee. From there, Jesus will send them as missionaries throughout the whole world to proclaim what they have seen and heard.

Now we will have fifty days to celebrate this Easter season and will hear how the ecclesial community of disciples celebrated the resurrection of Christ and brought this good news to the whole world. The Acts of the Apostles will recount on the following Sundays the miracles that the apostles will perform in the name of Christ and many sinners will join the ecclesial community through the forgiveness of their sins in baptism. All these stories will prepare us for the feast of Pentecost where the Church will receive the Holy Spirit to carry out her salvific mission to all the nations. It was not enough for the disciples to see Christ risen to speak in his name since we hear that often they were behind closed doors for fear of the Jews even after seeing Jesus risen from the dead. In addition to the resurrection of Christ, the community of disciples needed the Holy Spirit in order to not live their faith with a spirit of fear. Instead, they needed the Holy Spirit to live their faith with zeal and joy in evangelizing all the nations in spite of contradictions and challenges. This same Spirit will accompany some of them even to give their blood for the gospel.

The event of the resurrection and the mission of the Church may be too broad for our little understanding. Yet, we can celebrate and rejoice that God has saved us from our sins and has entrusted his salvific mission to us poor sinners just as He did to his disciples. They were able to accomplish this mission because of the Spirit of Christ in them, rather than because of their human virtues. Let us eagerly go back to announce the resurrection of Christ to whomever we meet just as the men and women did that early first day of the week.

Muy feliz pascua a todos los feligreses de Santa Rosa y a todos los que nos visitan durante este domingo de pascua.

Hemos llegado felizmente a este primer día de la semana en el cual algunas mujeres fueron con lágrimas en los ojos muy temprano al sepulcro para perfumar el cuerpo de Jesús. Pero Jesús ya no estaba allí, ha resucitado y los espera en Galilea. Desde allí, Jesús los enviara como misioneros por todo el mundo a proclamar lo que vieron y oyeron.



Ahora tendremos cincuenta días para celebrar este tiempo pascual y escucharemos como la comunidad eclesial de discípulos celebraron la resurrección de Cristo y llevaron la buena noticia por todo el mundo. Los Hechos de los apóstoles nos narraran en los próximos domingos los milagros que los apóstoles hicieron en nombre de Cristo y los muchos pecadores que se adherirán al número de los discípulos por el perdón de sus pecados a través del bautismo. Todas estas narraciones nos preparan para la fiesta de Pentecostés cuando la iglesia recibirá el Espíritu Santo para llevar a cabo la misión salvífica para todos los hombres. No fue suficiente para los discípulos ver en persona a Cristo

resucitado para comenzar a hablar en su nombre ya que escuchamos que estaban bajo puertas cerradas por miedo a los judíos incluso luego de presenciar la resurrección de Jesús. Aparte de presenciar en persona a Cristo resucitado, los discípulos necesitaban el Espíritu Santo para no vivir su fe con miedo. Al contrario, ellos necesitaban recibir el Espíritu Santo para vivir su fe en Cristo con celo y alegría evangelizando a todas las naciones a pesar de las contradicciones y desafíos. Este mismo espíritu los acompañará hasta el punto de dar su sangre por esa fe en Cristo.

El acontecimiento de la resurrección y la misión de la iglesia tal vez sea mucha más grande que nuestra pequeña mente. A pesar de esto, hoy podemos celebrar y regocijarnos que Dios nos ha salvado de nuestros pecados y nos ha confiado a nosotros pobres pecadores su misión salvífica, así como lo hizo con sus discípulos. Los discípulos pudieron llevar a cabo esta misión por el Espíritu de Cristo que habitaba en ellos y no por sus virtudes humanas. Volvamos apresuradamente a anunciar la resurrección de Cristo a quien sea que encontremos en nuestro camino así como las mujeres y apóstoles lo hicieron ese primer día de la semana después de ver el sepulcro vacío.

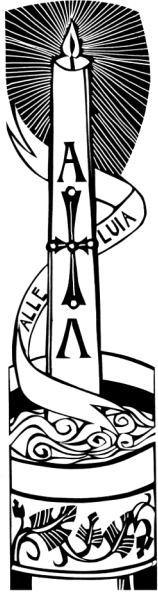
