# SCRIPTURE REFLECTION / REFLEXION DE LAS ESCRITURAS

Today we have arrived at the third Sunday of Easter after the resurrection. Jesus has been appearing to his disciples and we have been hearing in the readings what happened at each appearance. This Sunday, the story of Jesus' appearance to his disciples has three parts. First, Jesus appears at the seashore and commands his disciples to cast the net over the right side of the boat and they will find something. The disciples humbly obey Jesus' words and they witness the miraculous catch of hundreds of large fish.

Second, Jesus prepares a meal for them and eats with them. And thirdly, Jesus reaffirms the call to Peter to feed his sheep. Jesus does a sort of second call to Peter, a call within a call. At the first call, Peter was also fishing at the seashore. This second call today after the resurrection, Peter is again fishing and at the seashore.

However, this second time, Peter knows himself a bit more than the first time. He knows his weakness in following Jesus and, at the same time, knows more about the love and mercy of Christ. Jesus calls him again to feed his sheep, in spite of Peter's betrayal.

These three parts in today's gospel must be repeated over and over again in the life of every faithful. Sometimes we come to Mass disappointed by our weaknesses, the heavy burden of a week's work, our sins, or our failure in being faithful following Christ, just as Peter felt at his boat as Jesus came to the shore. Within this context of disappointment, Jesus comes at each Mass and gives us his word at the first part of Mass. He speaks to us and, if we are faithful to his word, we can experience the resurrection of our dead spirit. The word of God brings us back to life and introduces us to the second part of the Mass, where Jesus prepares a table and meal for us. We share his body and blood, which are the signs of his love for us even though we betray him sometimes. And this is not the end of the story. After Mass, Christ sends us to follow him to feed his flock, just as he did Peter.

This story of Christ's love and mercy for his disciples and, in a special way, for Peter, prepares our hearts not to get discouraged when we betray God with our sins. We must always trust in the mercy of Christ, who wants our repentance so that He may share his table with us and send us into the world to be his disciples. This dialogue of love between Jesus and Peter also prepares us for next Sunday, when we will hear about the good shepherd.



Hoy llegamos a los tres primeros domingos de pascua después de la resurrección de Jesucristo. Jesús se ha estado apareciendo a sus discípulos y estuvimos escuchando en las lecturas lo que ocurría en cada aparición. Este domingo, la aparición de Jesucristo a sus discípulos puede ser dividido en tres partes. Primera parte, Jesús aparece en la orilla del mar y manda a sus discípulos que tiren la red al otro lado del bote que allí pescaran algo. Los discípulos humildemente obedecen a las palabras de Jesús y son testigos de la pesca milagrosa con cientos de peces. Segundo parte, Jesús prepara una comida con sus discípulos y come con ellos. Y la tercera parte, Jesús reafirma la llamada de Pedro a apacentar sus ovejas. Jesús como que hace una segunda llamada a Pedro a seguirlo, una llamada dentro de una llamada. En la primera llamada, Pedro también estaba pescando a orillas del mar. En la segunda llamada hoy después de la resurrección, Pedro está de nuevo pescando a orillas del mar. Pero en esta segunda llamada, Pedro se conoce a sí mismo un

poco más que en la primera llamada. Pedro ahora conoce sus debilidades siguiendo a Jesús y, al mismo tiempo, conoce más el amor y la misericordia de Jesús. Es así que Jesús lo llama de vuelta a apacentar sus ovejas después de haberle traicionado.

Estas tres partes en el evangelio de hoy nos da un ejemplo de cómo puede ser vivida nuestra fe en la vida de cada feligrés. Algunas veces venimos a Misa decepcionados por nuestras debilidades, pecados y traiciones a Jesús. Venimos cansados por el duro trabajo de una semana. Nos sentimos como Pedro en el bote, indignos de acercarnos a Jesús porque somos pecadores. A pesar de esto, Jesús viene en cada Misa y dialoga con nosotros por medio de su palabra en la primera parte de la celebración eucarística. Él nos habla y, si somos fieles a sus palabras, podemos experimentar la resurrección de nuestro espíritu muerto. La palabra de Dios tiene poder de devolvernos la vida y nos introduce en la segunda parte de la Misa donde Jesús prepara un altar y un banquete nupcial para nosotros. Compartimos su cuerpo y su sangre que son signos de su amor para con nosotros por más que muchas veces le traicionamos. Y todo no termina aquí, sino que al final de la Misa, Jesús mismo nos envía para que le sigamos y apacentemos su rebaño así como lo hizo Pedro.

Este relato de amor y misericordia de Cristo para con sus discípulos, en especial con Pedro, prepara nuestro corazón para no desanimarnos cuando traicionamos a Jesús con nuestros pecados. Confiemos siempre en la misericordia de Jesús quien se place en nuestra conversión para que Él pueda compartir su banquete de amor con nosotros. Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This week we have begun the month of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Mary is the queen of May because for centuries, the Catholic Church has set aside the entire month of May to honor her, the Mother of God. During the Baroque times, the idea of a month dedicated to the Virgin Mary was born, with thirty daily spiritual exercises honoring Mary. This custom became especially widespread during the nineteenth century and remains in practice until today. Several Popes strongly encouraged us to welcome her within our lives as the refuge of sinners. People honor Mary in varied ways. Some parishes recite the rosary during May. Others organize Marian pilgrimages. Others put the statue or picture of Mary in a visible place with flowers to venerate it. In some traditions, there is also the Crowning of Mary. The crown usually is made of flowers, representing her beauty and virtue.

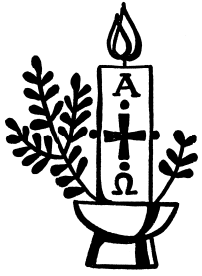
Let us give the Virgin Mary special prayers this month so that we may imitate her virtues of purity, humility, and obedience to her Son, Jesus Christ. I personally love to contemplate her semblance in some icons at my office and at the rectory. Those icons and statues at our Church always remind us that she is our mother.
