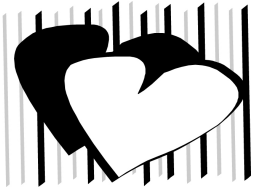

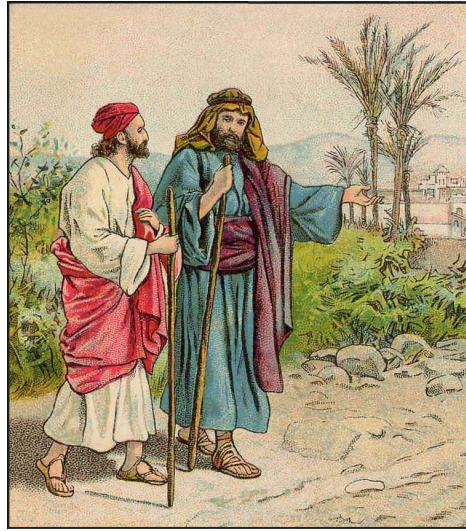

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION / REFLEXION DE LAS ESCRITURAS

From the fifth Sunday of Easter on, the dynamic of the readings shifts from celebration of the Lord's Resurrection to the preparation for the culmination of the paschal season, the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. The fact that the gospel readings on these Sundays are all taken from Christ's discourse at the end of the Last Supper underscores their profoundly Eucharistic significance. The readings and prayers will speak about the role of the Holy Spirit in the ongoing life of the Church.



On this Sunday, the first reading speaks of the brotherly communion between Paul and Barnabas evangelizing the gentiles and strengthening the spirits of the disciples to persevere in their faith in the midst of hardships. In the gospel, Jesus commands his disciples to love one another just as he has loved them. This is how all will know that we are disciples of Jesus.

The disciples witnessed the resurrection and now are preaching this good news everywhere. This evangelization is not the result of human efforts. This is the Holy Spirit at work in the Church. They witnessed the gospel because they had eternal life already inflamed within them. We may see the life of Paul and Barnabas as too hard because they suffered greatly to announce the gospel. Comparing their lives with ours, we may fall really short in being disciples of Christ because sometimes we cannot love our enemies as Jesus loved them or we may be too afraid to speak in Jesus' name wherever we go. Christian standards may feel a bit too high for our mere human mentality.

For this reason, we need the Spirit of God. Without the Holy Spirit, Christianity becomes mere utopia. The Holy Spirit can give us the zeal to announce the gospel, the joy to suffer hardships out of love for Christ. The Holy Spirit can also give us a docile heart to love our enemies. These actions are heavenly fruits of the Holy Spirit. We cannot stir these fruits up in us just with our poor human nature wounded by original sin. Christianity is not the result of human efforts. If we truly have the Holy Spirit, then we may have the courage to speak about Christ wherever we go and love our enemies, even if this entails to risk our physical life or being despised for it. The world needs these signs of the love, courage, zeal for the gospel to believe that we have the Spirit of God to be his disciples.

Desde el quinto domingo de pascua en adelante, las lecturas cambian de enfoque hacia la preparación para la culminación del tiempo pascual. Las lecturas ya no son tanto sobre la resurrección como lo es sobre la venida del Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés. El hecho que los evangelios de estos domingos son tomados de las palabras de Cristo en la última cena, nos enfatizan el significado de la eucaristía. Las lecturas y las oraciones hablarán sobre el rol del Espíritu Santo en lo que será la vida en la iglesia.

En este domingo, la primera lectura habla de la comunión fraterna que Pablo y Barnabas tenían evangelizando

a los gentiles. Ellos fortalecían los espíritus de los discípulos a perseverar en su fe en medio de adversidades. Y en el evangelio, Jesús encomienda a sus discípulos a amarse los unos a los otros así como el los ama. Es así como todos sabrán que somos discípulos de Jesucristo.

Si escuchamos estas lecturas solamente con una mentalidad humana, entonces nos daremos cuenta que no estamos dispuestos a ser discípulos de Jesús. Nuestra naturaleza humana nos apela a estar dentro de nuestro confort y no sufrir mucho por nuestra fe. Tal vez podemos ver la vida de Pablo y Barnabas como muy difícil porque ellos sufrieron grandemente anunciando el evangelio. Comparando nuestras vidas con la de ellos, tal vez quedamos cortos en ser discípulos de Cristo porque a veces no podemos amar a nuestros enemigos como Cristo los ama. Los estandartes cristianos pueden parecernos un poco altos para nuestra mera mentalidad humana.

Es por eso que necesitamos el Espíritu de Jesucristo. Sin el Espíritu Santo, el cristianismo se vuelve mera utopía. El Espíritu Santo nos puede dar el celo por anunciar el evangelio, la alegría de sufrir adversidades por el nombre de Jesús. El Espíritu Santo también nos puede dar un corazón dócil para amar a nuestros enemigos. Estas acciones son frutos celestiales del Espíritu Santo. No podemos producir estos frutos del Espíritu Santo en nosotros solo con nuestra pobre naturaleza humana herida por el pecado original. El cristianismo no es el resultado de nuestros esfuerzos humanos. Si realmente tenemos el Espíritu Santo dentro nuestro, entonces tendremos el fervor de hablar de Cristo donde sea que vayamos y amaremos a nuestros enemigos. El mundo necesita ver estos signos de amor y celo por Jesucristo gracias al Espíritu Santo para que todos sepan que somos discípulos de Jesús.
