PENTECOST (Acts 2:1-11)

Pentecost is the ‘Third Great Day’ in the church’s yearly calendar, after Easter and Christmas. In a real sense, it’s the birthday of the Church. It’s the day the Holy Spirit came upon the church in power for the very first time. And like the breath in our lungs right now, if we did not have the Holy Spirit, the church would be dead.

Some major changes took place on Pentecost. The disciples were huddled together in fear, when the sound of a blowing wind came down from heaven. What seemed to be tongues of fire settled on their heads.

If we read the text of Acts closely we see that Luke says ‘there appeared to them tongues as of fire’. It was the only way he could describe the manifestation of the Holy Spirit upon the disciples. Fire in scriptures often signified the holy presence of God – like the burning bush, the pillar of fire, the consuming fire on Mount Sinai and so on.

We are told that ‘The tongues of fire separated and rested upon each of them’. So the Spirit of God fell on the Apostles, in a mighty way. The point being made is that this is not literal fire. It’s symbolic.

They were filled with the Holy Spirit, and they were understood perfectly by people speaking different languages.

A crowd gathered and listened as the disciples preached the gospel. After Peter preached his sermon, 3000 people came to faith and were baptized.

We do know that Jerusalem was packed with people, because of the Jewish Festival of Pentecost - which was originally a harvest festival, celebrating the first cutting of wheat. And they came from all over the Roman Empire - speaking different languages.

Earlier, our lesson also says that suddenly a sound came from heaven like the rush of a mighty wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. By describing the noise as coming from heaven, Luke emphasizes that this was supernatural action. It was not a weather-related problem. The supernatural activity of God is so utterly beyond the grasp of humans that St Luke has to employ similes to describe His manifestations to us.

Acts goes on to tell us of the immediate changes that took place on Pentecost. No longer were the disciples confused or timid. Now, they were confident - speaking courageously in public.

Another incredible thing is the gift the disciples enjoyed, of being understood by people speaking different languages. Luke makes it clear that the disciples’ speech was clearly understood by a variety of people – 15 in all, representing all the nations of the world.

The lesson here is simple - the Holy Spirit comes to unite people from all the nations under the truth of the gospel of Jesus Christ.

And the wonderful message of Pentecost is that we really are not alone. The Holy Spirit walks with us and talks with us every day. Through good times and the bad, even though we are strangers on this earth, Jesus our Savior has not abandoned us. His Spirit lives on - the Holy Spirit is with us.

EL ENVÍO DEL ESPÍRITU SANTO

El Señor dijo a los discípulos: Id y haced discípulos de todos los pueblos, bautizándolos en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. Con este mandato les daba el poder de regenerar a los hombres en Dios. Dios había prometido por boca de sus profetas que en los últimos días derramaría su Espíritu sobre sus siervos y sier-vas, y que éstos profetizarían; por esto descendió el Espí-ritu Santo sobre el Hijo de Dios, que se había hecho Hijo del hombre, para así, permaneciendo en él, habitar en el género humano, reposar sobre los hombres y residir en la obra plasmada por las manos de Dios, realizando así en el hombre la voluntad del Padre y renovándolo de la an-tigua condición a la nueva, creada en Cristo. Y Lucas nos narra cómo este Espíritu, después de la ascensión del Señor, descendió sobre los discípulos el día de Pentecos-tés, con el poder de dar a todos los hombres entrada en la vida y para dar su plenitud a la nueva alianza; por esto, todos a una, los discípulos alababan a Dios en todas las lenguas, al reducir el Espíritu a la unidad de los pueblos distantes y ofrecer al Padre las primicias de todas las na-ciones. Por esto el Señor prometió que nos enviaría aquel Defensor que nos haría capaces de Dios. Pues, del mis-mo modo que el trigo seco no puede convertirse en una masa compacta y en un solo pan, si antes no es humede-cido, así también nosotros, que somos muchos, no podí-a-mos convertirnos en una sola cosa en Cristo Jesús, sin esta agua que baja del cielo. Y, así como la tierra árida no da fruto, si no recibe el agua, así también nosotros, que éramos antes como un leño árido, nunca hubiéramos dado el fruto de vida, sin esta gratuita lluvia de lo alto. Nuestros cuerpos, en efecto, recibieron por el baño bau-tismal la unidad destinada a la incorrupción, pero nues-tras almas la recibieron por el Espíritu. El Espíritu de Dios descendió sobre el Señor, Espíritu de prudencia y sabiduría, Espíritu de consejo y de valentía, Espíritu de ciencia y temor del Señor, y el Señor, a su vez, lo dio a la Iglesia, enviando al Defensor sobre toda la tierra desde el cielo, que fue de donde dijo el Señor que había sido arro-jado Satanás como un rayo; por esto necesitamos de este rocío divino, para que demos fruto y no seamos lanzados al fuego; y, ya que tenemos quien nos acusa, tengamos también un Defensor, pues que el Señor encomienda al Espíritu Santo el cuidado del hombre, posesión suya, que había caído en manos de ladrones, del cual se compade-ció y vendió sus heridas, entregando después los dos de-narios regios para que nosotros, recibiendo por el Espíri-tu la imagen y la inscripción del Padre y del Hijo, haga-mos fructificar el denario que se nos ha confiado, retor-nándolo al Señor con intereses.
