Pentecost (Acts 2:1-11)

If you are parents, did you ever warn your child not to speak to strangers? This warning can be very helpful and keeping our children safe is so important. Today, though, we hear that Pentecost is about when it is really good to speak with strangers.

That first Pentecost happened in the city of Jerusalem, but today's story from Acts really refers to two cities. The first city our story refers to is the city of Babel. It's not mentioned in Acts, but it's there, right beneath the surface, and the first readers of the Acts of the Apostles would not have missed it.

The story of Babel is mentioned in Genesis 11. It was told by our ancient Hebrew forebears in faith to explain the multiplicity of peoples and languages and nations. How is it, they asked even then, that humans must have had one common beginning, and yet, look at us – people speak so many languages, appear in so many colors, are spread all over the world? How is it, that if we all at some time came from one common beginning, we can't understand one another – that when strangers from another land speak, it sounds like babbling to us? This is the story they told.

But the people decided to make a name for themselves – so says the book of Genesis. They were tired of trusting in God, and they weren't all that good at it anyway. So, they decided to build a city, and in the middle of that city they would build a tower reaching up to the heavens and bring themselves some fame. God heard about this plan, and Genesis says, God scrambled up their language. The people can no longer communicate; they become strangers to one another. They scatter, and the city is called Babel, because that's what it sounded like. That's city number one.

Now come to the city of Jerusalem. It's 50 days after Jesus' resurrection. Jesus has told his followers to wait together in the city because Jesus will send the Holy Spirit to be with them, to comfort them and strengthen them and guide them into all truth.

Suddenly, to the followers of Jesus, comes the Holy Spirit. First the rush of a violent wind. Then tongues of fire rest on each of them. Then, as they are filled with the Holy Spirit, they begin to speak in other languages. And people from everywhere can hear and understand in their very own language.

In Jerusalem on Pentecost, through the power of the Holy Spirit, the obstacle of Babel was undone. On that day, the diversity of languages was not a curse, but a marvel. And this is important: God undid Babel, not by bringing the whole world back into speaking one language. Pentecost affirms the diversity of the world, the richness of the multitude of peoples and languages, and the gift when you hear and understand, when people can communicate, whether across the barriers of languages, or the barrier of simply being one stranger speaking with another.

On this Pentecost Sunday, let's reflect on this powerful work of the Holy Spirit, in uniting people.

Pentecostés (Hch 2: 1-11)

Pentecostés era una fiesta judía, en realidad la “Fiesta de las Semanas” o de las primicias de la recolección. Son siete semanas completas desde la pascua; es decir, cuarenta y nueve días. En ese caso, una tradición anterior a Lucas, muy probablemente, habría cristianizado el calendario litúrgico judío.

Pero ese es el trasfondo solamente, de la misma manera que lo es, también sin duda, el episodio de la Torre de Babel, en el relato de Gn 11,1-9. Y sin duda, tiene una importancia sustancial, ya que Lucas no se queda solamente en los episodios exclusivamente israelitas. De hecho, tiene muchas posibilidades teológicas el reclamo y el trasfondo sobre la torre de babel. Porque Babel, Babilonia, ha sido para el pueblo bíblico el prototipo de la idolatría, del poder contaminante y tirano, opuesto a Dios. Podemos ver una contraposición entre la “globalización” de Babel y cómo ahora viene el Espíritu a la comunidad en Jerusalén. Ahora, ya no para conquistar a los pueblos, sino para mostrar como Dios se incultura en todas las razas y lenguas por medio de su Espíritu.

Por eso mismo, no es una Ley nueva lo que se recibe en el día de Pentecostés, sino el don del Espíritu de Dios o del Espíritu del Señor. Es un cambio sustancial y decisivo y un don incomparable. Es el Espíritu el único que hace posible que todos los hombres, no sólo los israelitas, entren a formar parte del nuevo pueblo.

Lo que Lucas quiere subrayar, pues, es la universalidad que caracteriza el tiempo del Espíritu y la habilitación profética del nuevo pueblo de Dios. El don del Espíritu, en Pentecostés, es un fenómeno profético por el que todos escuchan cómo se interpreta al alcance de todos la “acción salvífica de Dios”; no es un fenómeno de idiomas, sino que esto acontece en el corazón de los hombres.

El relato de Pentecostés que hoy leemos es un conjunto que abarca muchas experiencias a la vez, no solamente de un día. Esta fiesta de la Iglesia, que nace en las Pascua de su Señor, es como su bautismo de fuego. Porque ¿de qué vale ser bautizado si no se confiesa ante el mundo en nombre de quién hemos sido bautizados y el sentido de nuestra vida? Por eso, el día de la fiesta del Pentecostés, en que se conmemora el don de la ley en el Sinaí como garantía de la Alianza de Dios con su pueblo, se nos describe que en el seno de la comunidad de los discípulos del Señor se operó un cambio definitivo por medio del Espíritu. De esa manera se quiere significar que desde ahora Dios conducirá a su pueblo, un pueblo nuevo, la Iglesia, por medio del Espíritu y ya no por la ley. Desde esa perspectiva se le quiere dar una nueva identidad profética a ese pueblo, que dejará de ser nacionalista, cerrado, exclusivista. La Iglesia debe estar abierta a todos los hombres, a todas las razas y culturas, porque nadie puede estar excluido de la salvación de Dios. De ahí que se quiera significar todo ello con el don de lenguas, o mejor, con que todos los hombres entiendan ese proyecto salvífico de Dios en su propia lengua y en su propia cultura. Esto es lo que pone fin al episodio desconcertante de la torre de Babel en que cada hombre y cada grupo se fue por su camino para “independizarse de Dios”. Eso es lo que lleva a cabo el Espíritu Santo: la unificación armoniosa de la humanidad en un mismo proyecto salvífico divino.

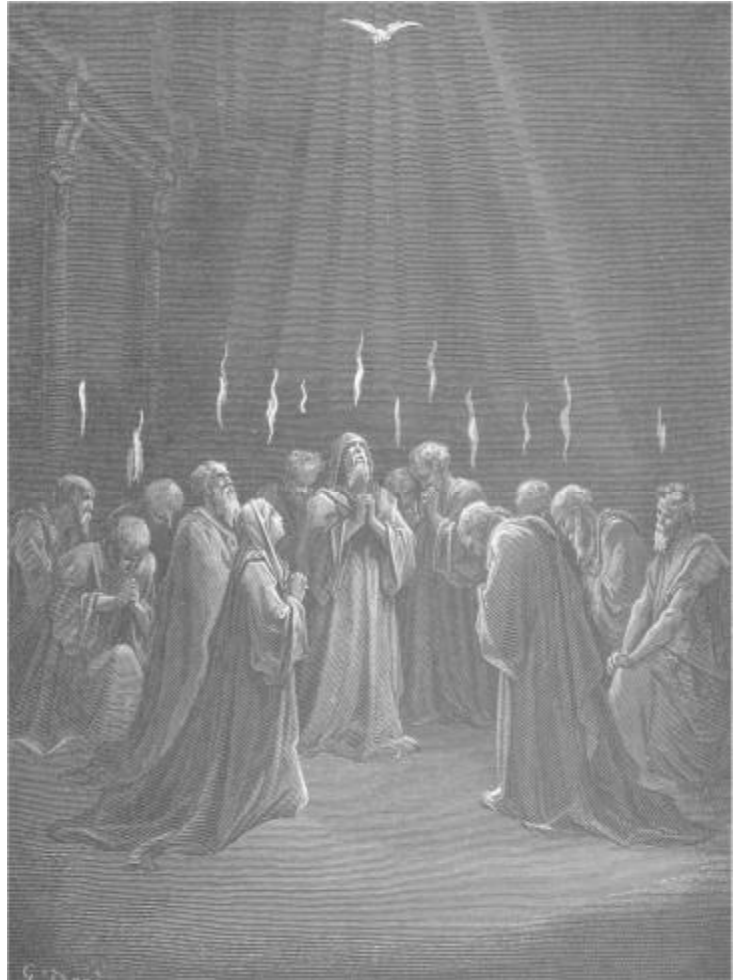
